*Authority Financial Analyst Lidia Aronova summarized the proposal and Staff's analysis. Tony Glenn was present on behalf of the Applicant. Mr. Glenn expressed his consent and support to an adjustment of 3% rather than 5% as originally sought. Approved 3-0 at 3%.*

*Commissioner Assad summarized the Application and recommended approval. Legal counsel Brent Carson, Esq. was present on behalf of the Applicant. Mr. Carson stated that the Applicant would refer to other carriers any transport that required special accommodation such as non-ambulatory transportation. Approved 3-0.*

**79. Docket 13-04030** The Joint Application of CLS Nevada, LLC d/b/a CLS Transportation Las Vegas and Proper Transportation, LLC pursuant to NAC 706.359 requesting approval for the temporary transfer of operating rights under Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity 1011, Sub 4 and 2066, Sub 1, to Proper Transportation, LLC pending the application and approval of the final sale and transfer. Staff investigation concluded.

*Legal Counsel Brent Carson, Esquire, David Chesnoff, Esquire, Transferor owner Charles Horky and Transferee owner Jason Propp were present on behalf of the Applicants. Mr. Chesnoff stated that a signed plea agreement in Charles Horky's criminal matter was pending acceptance by a federal judge, and that Mr. Chesnoff had in his trust account the funds for the required payment pursuant to the agreement. Authority Staff reported a need for further investigation of transferor and transferee fitness. By a vote of 3-0 the Authority assigned the matter to a Presiding Officer (a Las Vegas-based commissioner to be determined) for purposes of conducting a hearing on the proposed temporary transfer.*

**82. Docket 14-05010** The Order to Show Cause issued to CLS Las Vegas, LLC dba United Car Service and United as to why Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 1011 should not be revoked. (AJM)

*Chairman MacKay summarized the procedural history of the docket and the reasoning behind the Order to Show Cause. Brent Carson, Esquire appeared on behalf of CLS/United. A discussion ensued with regard to the number of alleged violations, the severity of the violations and the remedies taken. Motion not to revoke or suspend CPCN 1011 – Approved 3-0*

**83. Docket 13-06007** The Authority will consider approval of template documents for designated storage lot indemnification agreements, in conformity with NRS 706.4489(7)(a) and NRS 706.4489(4). (AJM)

*Chairman MacKay summarized the procedural history of the docket. David Walker, Walker Towing, questioned the provisions of the documents. Jerry Carnahan, E & E, Abe Parham, Copart, and David Walker, Walker Towing, participated in the discussion. Adoption of template documents was approved by a vote of 3-0*

**84. Dockets 13-06007-H through 13-06007-U** Pursuant to NRS 706.4489(7), the Authority will consider request(s) from Mendakota Insurance Company; Metropolitan Property and Casualty Insurance Co.; Sentry Insurance Co.; COUNTRY Mutual, COUNTRY Preferred, and COUNTRY Casualty; Merastar Insurance Company (a Kemper Corporation Company) and its subsidiaries; USAA; Amica Mutual Insurance Company; Liberty Mutual Insurance Company & affiliates, meaning those entities under common control with LMIC; Interinsurance Exchange of the Automobile Club (and its eight additional “doing business as” names); Progressive Insurance; California Casualty; Esurance Insurance Company; Esurance Property and Casualty Insurance Company; and CSE Insurance for designation of the vehicle storage lot operated by Copart, Inc. dba 57 Storage. **86.** At the request of Authority Staff, the Authority will discuss the interpretation and application of NAC 706.3612, including but not limited to the circumstances under which a driver may exceed 12 hours of service pursuant to the exception set forth in NAC 706.3612(1). Staff investigation concluded.

*Item tabled, to be heard at a subsequent Agenda meeting. Approved 3-0*

**87. Docket 14-05015** In a May 12, 2014 letter addressed to Chairman Andrew J. MacKay, Integrity Vehicle Solutions Co. proposed that the Authority adopt standard “e-hail” tariff rates and fees that charter limousine carriers could subsequently apply to add to their tariffs. The Authority will consider whether to open a tariff investigative docket and assign a Presiding Officer.

*Neal Tomlinson, Esquire appeared on behalf of Integrity Vehicle Solutions. A discussion ensued with regard to submission of e-hail tariffs in the interim. Hearing officer to be assigned and a hearing will be scheduled. Approved 3-0*
