AGENDA

1. Call to Order

Chairman Andrew J. MacKay called the meeting to order at approximately 9:33am.

2. Roll Call

3. Pledge of Allegiance

Compliance Audit Investigator John Datian led a recital of the Pledge.

4. Public Comment

Paul Sprada, owner of AA Buffalo One Towing, stated that it is difficult to be profitable because Las Vegas is at the saturation point for tow carriers, plus there are many unlawful operators marked "not for hire."

5. Approval of Agenda

Administrative Attorney Jim Day requested that Item 16 be removed from the Agenda. Agenda approved as amended by a vote of 3-0.

6. Approval of the Minutes of the June 13, 2014 Agenda Meeting Approved 3-0

7. Briefings from the Commissioners

Chairman MacKay, Commissioner Sakelhide and Commissioner Assad thanked Authority Staff and expressed gratitude to John Datian for his service as he enters retirement.

8. Briefing from the Deputy Commissioner

Deputy Commissioner Skibinski wished John Datian well in his retirement and reported on the Authority's performance measures for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.

9. Report of Legal Counsel

Senior Deputy Attorney General Newton updated the status of pending cases and reported a new civil suit regarding an incident at the airport about two years ago.

DISCUSSION ITEM

10. Docket 14-05015 The Authority at its June 2014 general session opened an investigative docket and assigned Commissioner Keith Sakelhide as Presiding Officer for purposes of gathering information regarding electronic hailing applications. Commissioner Sakelhide will report his findings and recommendations for consideration of the Authority. (KAS)

Applications Manager Liz Babcock reported that within the past two days LVL, Presidential and Bell Trans have filed tariff modifications to accommodate electronic hailing. Neal Tomlinson, legal counsel for Integrity Vehicle Solutions Company offered a statement regarding his company's Ride Genie product.

PETITION TO DEVIATE FROM REGULATION

11. Docket 14-07004 Petitioner Integrity Vehicle Solutions Company seeks Authority approval to deviate pursuant to NAC 706.1305 from NAC 706.311 to allow the Petitioner to collect a fee from the user of an electronic ride hailing application. If approved, the Petitioner would collect from the user this fee, the tariff rate of the providing carrier, and any gratuity. The Petitioner would retain the full amount of such fee, and remit to the carrier the total tariff rate (including any approved surcharges) less a commission or referral fee (not to exceed 10%) as authorized by NAC 706.311(2), and the full amount of the gratuity, if any. Neal Tomlinson, legal counsel for Integrity Vehicle Solution Company summarized the Petition, and answered questions regarding the "good cause" underlying the request. Chairman MacKay emphasized that the deviation would be an interim solution conditional upon the filing of language to add to the ongoing rulemaking document. Temporary deviation approved by a vote of 3-0, for the duration of the current rulemaking docket.

Administrative Attorney James Allen Day confirmed the Deputy Commissioner's account. The Petitioner provided a new address of 6415 Cachua Ct., Sun Valley, 89433. Items 87 and 89 were considered jointly. Legal counsel Theodore Kurtz was present on behalf of the Applicants. Commissioner Sakelhide and Applications Manager Liz Babcock summarized the Applications and recommended approval. Both Items approved by a vote of 3-0.

Staff investigation concluded. (AJM)

Chairman MacKay summarized the Application and recommended approval, noting Staff support. Approved by a vote of 3-0.

Docket 13-08003 The Joint application of LIFETRANS, Inc., a non-profit corporation, for authority to sell and transfer and of LIFETRANS, Inc., a for profit corporation, to purchase and acquire the authority to provide non-emergency medical transportation services granted under CPCN 1114. Staff investigation concluded. (GA)

Commissioner Assad summarized the Application and recommended approval, noting Staff support. Applications Manager Liz Babcock confirmed Staff support and reported that the transfer would result in no operational changes. Approved by a vote of 3-0.

91. Docket 13-10007 The Application of Limousines of LV Parking, LLC d/b/a Nevada Limousine Service for an expansion of operating authority granted under Contract Carrier Permit MV 6148. Staff investigation concluded. (GA)

Commissioner Assad summarized the Application and recommended denial. Commissioner Sakelhide reported that he had listened to the hearing and reviewed the transcripts and expressed support for Commissioner Assad's proposed Order. Chairman MacKay reported that he had listened to the hearing and reviewed transcripts and that he also concurred with the proposed Order. Co-owner Melody Malone was present on behalf of the Applicant along with legal counsel William Heaton, Esq. The Motion for Partial Summary Judgment was denied by a vote of 3-0. The proposed Order denying the Application was approved as drafted by a vote of 3-0.

STORAGE LOT DESIGNATION REQUESTS

92. Dockets 13-06007-V through 13-06007-BB Pursuant to NRS 706.4489(7), the Authority will consider requests from Assurance America; Century-National Ins. Co.; Travelers Insurance; Ameriprise Auto & Home Insurance; Bristol West Insurance Company/Coast National Insurance; Bristol West Insurance Company/Foremost Insurance; and Bristol West Insurance Company/Bristol West Insurance for designation of the vehicle storage lot operated by Copart, Inc. dba 57 Storage. The Authority will consider ratification of interim approval of storage lot designations with respect to jurisdictions for which an executed indemnification agreement has been provided in conformity with NRS 706.4489(7)(a) and NRS 706.4489(4). (AJM)

Chairman MacKay summarized the requests and recommended that the full Authority ratify his interim approvals. Approved 3-0.

93. Dockets 13-06007-CC through 13-06007-JJ Pursuant to NRS 706.4489(7), the Authority will consider request(s) from Mercury Insurance Services, LLC; Farmers Insurance Exchange & Affiliates; Allstate Insurance Company; and CSA AIG Insurance Group dba AAA Nevada; each for designation of two vehicle storage lots operated by E&E Vehicle Solutions. The Authority will consider ratification of interim approval of storage lot designations with respect to jurisdictions for which an executed indemnification agreement has been provided in conformity with NRS 706.4489(7)(a) and NRS 706.4489(4). (AJM)

Chairman MacKay summarized the requests and recommended that the full Authority ratify his interim approval. Approved 3-0.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

94. Docket 14-06001 Model Tow Tariff modifications regarding non-consent tows for cash discounts pursuant to NRS 706.44797. Staff investigation concluded.

Applications Manager Liz Babcock summarized the modifications and requested two sets, one with the discount and one without. It was determined the 3% discount rate would be used and the original docket to remain open for 12 months to obtain additional historical data. Jeff Sawin, Drew Ribar (Reno), David Walker and Thomas Turner discussed the math formula for the 3% increase. Approved 3-0

95. Docket 14-07001 The Authority will discuss the propriety of a tow carrier requiring a customer/vehicle owner to enter into an "Agreement for Vehicle Lien" as a condition of acceptance of credit cards as required by NRS 706.44793. (KAS)

Thomas Turner, Legal Counsel and Co-Owner of Tow Pros summarized the discussion item. Commissioner Sakelhide indicated the agreement for lien was not lawful. Commissioner Sakelhide's position was adopted by the full Authority by a vote of 3-0

96. At the request of Authority Staff, the Authority will discuss the interpretation and application of NAC 706.3612, including but not limited to the circumstances under which a driver may exceed 12 hours of service pursuant to the exception set forth in NAC 706.3612(1). Staff investigation concluded.

Senior Deputy Attorney General Newton summarized the circumstances that initiated the discussion item. Commissioner Sakelhide detailed the requirements of the regulation. A lengthy discussion ensued. Terry Flink, Las Vegas Limousines posed several scenarios with regard to charters and hours of service. Kimberly Maxson-Rushton, Esquire suggested requesting a deviation during peak conventions. Jahn Herrick, Lucky Limousines expressed concerns about Nevada hours of service being more stringent than comparable Federal standards.

97. Public Comment

Dwight Kazee, Citywide Towing, questioned Items 92 and 93 and the storage lot provisions. David Walker, Walker Towing made a statement regarding his last appearance before the Authority.
