## DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 59.** At the request of Authority Staff, the Authority will discuss the tariff template used for the interim-approved 3% passenger recovery charge. Specifically, to address whether the tariff template will become permanent as is or require the carriers to remove the tariff template and modify their current tariff rates to offset the recovery charge and set an expiration date for such modifications. Staff investigation concluded. – ***FOR POSSIBLE ACTION***
- 60.** Assembly Bill 385 (78<sup>th</sup> Nevada Legislature 2015) requires that exceptions to the obligation to tow a vehicle to a designated storage lot be confirmed on a form *prescribed by the Authority* if there is not a law enforcement officer on the scene to approve such diversion.
