**MINUTES OF THE November 14, 2016 WORKSHOP TO
SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

1. Call to Order

Commissioner Keith A. Sakelhide called the workshop to order at 2:00 p.m.

The purpose of this workshop is to determine impact of the proposed regulations on small businesses and to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations:

- 1) Discussion regarding possible regulations regarding what are commonly referred to as relocation tows within the towing industry.

The proposal has been designated as Docket Number 16-10025 by the Authority. A copy of all materials relating to the proposal may be obtained at the workshop. There is currently no proposed regulatory language.

Commissioner Sakelhide detailed the reasoning behind the workshop and requested comments.

The following participated in the discussion: Camilla Sparks, United Road Towing (URT), Clark Whitney, Ewing Bros., Tom Baumbach, CalNevada Towing in Reno, Tony Glenn, Ashley's Towing each offered questions and statements. The determination was made that relocations tows should be considered non-consent tows as the vehicle owner has had no communication with the tow company and no opportunity to negotiate cost. Noticing and proper signage: Clark Whitney, Ewing Bros., Camilla Sparks, URT, Jeff Berry, Quality Towing

Agreement with property manager, limitations, costs of relocation and reimbursement: Clark Whitney, Ewing Bros.

Destination and fees: Vehicle must remain on property or within secured site. Clark Whitney, Ewing Bros., Tony Glenn, Ashley's Towing; Curtis Vahl, Roadside Rescue in Reno. Suggestion made to write one receipt for each vehicle towed as protection for tow company. Robert Segura, Quality Towing offered several discussion points.

Any written comments should be provided to Administrative Attorney Newton within the next 30 days to be presented at the next workshop meeting.
