**MINUTES OF THE June 1, 2018 WORKSHOP TO  
SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

**1. Call to Order**

*Commissioner David Newton called the workshop to order at 9:32 a.m.*

**The proposal has been designated as Docket Number 18-05001:**

- 1) Discuss potential changes to NAC 706.1355, "Public Notice of Application or Tariff Filing;"
- 2) Discuss potential changes to NAC 706.155, "Notice of Application for Certificate or Permit; hearing;"
- 3) Discuss potential changes NAC 706.208, "Lease of equipment by authorized carrier; Generally;"
- 4) Discuss potential changes to NAC 706.210, "Lease of Vehicle by Common Motor Carrier for Use as Traditional Limousine or Livery Limousine,"
- 5) Discuss potential changes to NAC 706.3982, "Hearings: Notice of Hearing;"
- 6) Discuss potential changes to Sec. 27 of LCB File No. 135-17
- 7) Discuss potential changes to Sec. 35 of LCB File No. 135-17
- 8) Discuss potential changes to Sec. 48 of LCB File No. 135-17,
- 9) Discuss potential changes to Sec. 52 of LCB File No. 135-17,
- 10) Discuss potential changes to Sec. 97 of LCB File No. 135-17, and
- 11) Other matters related thereto

**2. Discussion and public comment**

*Commissioner Newton detailed the proposed changes.*

*In Reno:*

*Chairman Gibbons stated there are two people in attendance but neither person wanted to make public comment at this time.*

*In Las Vegas:*

*Kimberly Maxson-Rushton, Esq. on behalf of the Livery Operators Association discussed concerns of notification by publication in the rural areas. She also discussed Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 4 & 5b both address notice by publication. Commissioner Newton explained that when he looked at NRCPC 223b it does not define publication. Rushton*

*stated that NRCP 223b leaves it to the State Agencies, but Rule 5b states electronic notification is only accepted if the parties agree to it.*

*Deputy Commissioner Jennifer DeRose discussed problems the agency has had with noticing.*

*Commissioner Newton discussed benefits to noticing on our website versus in the newspaper.*

*Kristina Kleist on the behalf of Hyperion Advisors discussed their request to NAC 706.208 removing the one to one requirement. Commissioner Newton stated that another workshop will occur to include her requested changes.*

*Commissioner Assad discussed his concerns regarding due process and noticing both on our website and newspaper.*

*Liz Babcock stated the costs for statewide notice in the newspapers to publish the notice for one day.*

*No other comments in Reno or Las Vegas.*
