  - Capitol Cab (Citations 20925, 23040)
    - Citation 20925 was fined \$200 with \$100 in abeyance leaving an amount due of \$100.
    - Citation 23040 was fined \$0 however the suspended fine of \$200 from Citation 20919 was triggered due and owing.
  - Executive Limousine Service Inc. (Citations 20924, 23041)
    - Citation 20924 and 23041 were fined a total of \$1,600 with \$800 in abeyance leaving an amount due of \$800.
  - Reno Cab Co. (Citation 20864, 20923, 23042)
    - Citation 20864, 20923 and 23042 were fined a total of \$2,000 with \$800 in abeyance leaving an amount due of \$1,200.
  - Yellow Cab (Citations 21451, 23043).

On 05/16/2021 the Amended Petition for Reconsideration was filed by Roy L. Street for the multiple CPCN citations approved at the January GSM as referenced. The hearings for Citations 20869, 20870, 20871 and 20872 were continued pending the resolution of the PFR which is in reference to the original citations 20925, 23040, 20924, 23041, 20864, 20923, 23042, 21451 and 23043.

**ORDER**

On December 3, 2020, a hearing on the above-captioned matter was held before Chairman Dawn Gibbons, serving in her capacity as Hearing Officer for the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority"). The Respondent, Roy L. Street d/b/a Capitol Cab Company was present through their manager, Mercy Medina. Ms. Medina elected to proceed without counsel.

After hearing the allegations, the respective arguments, and having considered the evidence introduced by both parties and being fully advised, the Hearing Officer, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC") 706.4015, prepared a proposed decision for review by the Authority. Based on that proposed decision, the Authority enters the following final order affirming the decision of the Hearing Officer. Under Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

At hearing, the parties knowingly and voluntarily stipulated and agreed as follows:

1. To admit into evidence the Citation 20925 and the related Investigation Report (marked as State's Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference) and that the facts as set forth therein were true and accurate;



2. That the Respondent's actions constituted violation of NAC 706.3751(1)(b) related to allowing a driver to operate a vehicle with an expired NTA permit;
3. To a fine in the amount of \$200.00 for the NAC 706.3751(1)(b) violation with \$100.00 of said fine amount suspended pending no further violations of NAC 706 within one year and timely payment of the fine amount; and
4. To waive the requirement that the Authority's final order contain formal Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required under NRS 233B.125.

### DISCUSSION

The Hearing Officer recommended to the Authority:

1. That the stipulations and agreements of the parties as set forth hereinabove be accepted; and
2. That findings enter against the Respondent for the violation of NAC 706.3751(1)(b).

### ORDER

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, based on the foregoing:**

1. That the recommendation of the Hearing Officer for Administrative Citation and Verified Complaint 20925 issued to Roy L. Street d/b/a Capitol Cab Company for the NAC 706.3751(1)(b) violation is hereby AFFIRMED;
2. The total fine shall be in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$200.00), with One Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100.00) of said fine amount to be suspended pending no further violations of NAC 706 within one year and timely payment of the fine amount; and

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3. That the Authority retains jurisdiction for correcting any errors that may have occurred in the drafting or issuance of this Order.

SUBJECT: **ORDER OF THE AUTHORITY**

Dear CAPITOL CAB COMPANY:

On January 28, 2021, you were fined \$200 for Citation number 20925 for violation of NRS or NAC 706 with \$100 held in abeyance pursuant to the conditions as set forth in the attached Order.

Your payment of \$100 may be satisfied via the options listed below:

- **Reno Office:** Payments can be made via mail service or in-person during normal business hours, Monday through Friday.
- **Las Vegas Office:** Due to COVID-19 closures, payments must be sent to this location in the form of check, money order or cashier check via mail service.

If you fail to pay the amount due in twenty (20) days from the date of this letter, as set forth above, an order will be filed for you to show cause which could lead to the revocation of your certificate. Additionally, any amount that was held in abeyance in return for timely payment of the amount owed will become due and the balance subject to collection. Pursuant to NRS Chapter 353C, if your debt is turned over to a collection agency, you will be required to pay a 2 percent fee to the State Controller, as well as collection costs and fees of up to 35 percent of the debt or \$50,000, whichever is less. Information concerning your debt can be placed on the Controller's website for public inspection. NRS Chapter 353C also allows that the State may suspend, cancel, or refuse to renew certain licenses and permits you and your company may hold.

**ORDER**

On December 3, 2020, a hearing on the above-captioned matter was held before Chairman Dawn Gibbons, serving in her capacity as Hearing Officer for the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority"). The Respondent, Yellow Cab of Reno, Inc. was present through their manager, Mercy Medina. Ms. Medina elected to proceed without counsel.

After hearing the allegations, the respective arguments, and having considered the evidence introduced by both parties and being fully advised, the Hearing Officer, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC") 706.4015, prepared a proposed decision for review by the Authority. Based on that proposed decision, the Authority enters the following final order affirming the decision of the Hearing Officer. Under Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

At hearing, the parties knowingly and voluntarily stipulated and agreed as follows:

1. To admit into evidence the Citations 21451 and 23043 and the related Investigation Reports (marked as State's Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference) and that the facts as set forth therein were true and accurate;

**On March 21, 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the above listed companies initiated a program that changed the way we collected each company's portion of driver revenue. This was done to ensure we maintained our dwindling driver base, and to ensure that our drivers had adequate resources to buy food and pay their bills.**

### **Example:**

**March 21, 2020**

**Reno-Sparks Cab Company and other sub-companies listed above received no revenue from its drivers. Several weeks later RSCC increased its revenue share with drivers to 25% and continued incremental increases of 25% driver revenue share until March 21, 2020 when RSCC resumed a 50-50 split in revenue with our drivers.**

**As a result of this program Reno-Sparks Cab Company lost more than \$223,000 in revenue between the dates of March 21, 2020 and May 28, 2020. Additionally, due to the pandemic RSCC responded to unfunded mandates from the State and purchased over \$8,000 dollars' worth of disinfectants and hand sanitizers as well as plex-glass barriers to protect our employees.**

Due to our desire to help employees and because of unbudgeted expenditures RSCC finds itself unable to pay fines listed in citations referenced above. RSCC requests to petition for reconsideration of these fines for the reasons given.
