**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Las Vegas Party Coach, LLC dba ELS ("Applicant") has filed an application, designated as Docket 13-07018, with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide Charter Bus services within the State of Nevada.

The Authority at its June 13, 2014 general session determined that it had inadequate information to determine whether the Applicant's proposed operation would comply with the requirements of NRS 706.391(6) and NRS 706.463, based upon the Applicant's objection to his CPCN including the Authority's standard restriction prohibiting "Kelly" or walk-up services.

The Authority remanded the matter to Staff and directed Commissioner Keith A. Sakelhide, in his capacity as Presiding Officer, to conduct a hearing on this limited issue. Accordingly, under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority to hold a hearing in this matter, and pursuant to applicable sections of NRS 233B, NRS 706, and NAC 706, a Hearing Officer has been designated to conduct a hearing.




At which time a Hearing Officer will receive testimony and evidence regarding the Application, and decide which testimony and evidence will be delivered to the Authority for final determination.

Specifically, the Authority will consider evidence regarding the Applicant's justification for omitting from its CPCN the standard restriction against "Kelly" or walk-up service, and whether the Applicant has complied with the requirements set forth in NRS 706.463 that apply to charter bus applicants.
