NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS

**Airline Limousine Corporation d/b/a Airline Shuttle Corp (“ALC”) and Airline Shuttle, LLC (“AS”)** (collectively “Applicants”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 14-10021 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority for ALC to transfer and AS to acquire 100% of ALC, a carrier authorized to provide charter bus, charter limousine, airport transfer, and special services within Clark County, Nevada granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 2050, Sub 4. Frias Standard Capital, Inc. (“FSC”) will serve as sole manager of AS.

**Las Vegas Limousines, A Nevada Corporation (“LVL-C”) and Las Vegas Limousines, LLC (“LVL-L”)** (collectively “Applicants”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 14-10022 with the Authority for authority for LVL-C to transfer and LVL-L to acquire 100% of LVL-C, a carrier authorized to provide charter limousine, and airport transfer services within Clark County, Nevada granted under CPCN 2258, Sub 5. FSC will serve as sole manager of LVL-L.

**Frias Holding Company, A Nevada Corporation (“FHC-C”) and Frias Holding Company, LLC (“FHC-L”)** (collectively “Applicants”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 14-10023 with the Authority for authority for FHC-C to transfer and FHC-L to acquire 100% of FHC-C. FHC-C is the owner of LVL-C and ALC-C, carriers authorized to provide charter bus, charter limousine, airport transfer, and special services under CPCNs 2258, Sub 5 and 2050, Sub 4, respectively. FSC will serve as sole manager of FHC-L.

The applications were filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over these matters.

The applications are on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filings may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before December 1, 2014.
