NOTICE OF APPLICATION

AWG Ambassador, LLC d/b/a Ritz Transportation and SuperShuttle of Las Vegas, LLC (“Applicants”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 13-12027 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for AWG Ambassador, LLC to sell and transfer and SuperShuttle of Las Vegas, LLC to purchase and acquire the authority to provide charter livery limousine service, special service and airport transfer service conducted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 1089, Sub2 within Clark County, Nevada and to provide charter bus service, special service and airport transfer service conducted under CPCN 2055, Sub 2 within the State of Nevada. The application may include tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over these matters.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before February 24, 2014.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
