NOTICE OF AMENDED APPLICATION

AWG Ambassador, LLC d/b/a AWG Charter Services and Las Vegas Car Service, LLC (“Applicants”) have filed an amendment to their joint application, designated as Docket 14-11041 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) seeking approval to temporarily transfer operating rights, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) 706.359 for services conducted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 1068, Sub 4, from AWG Ambassador, LLC to Las Vegas Car Service, LLC for a period of two years or until the Authority’s approval of the sale and transfer, whichever comes first. This application may include tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

The application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before May 1, 2015.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s office. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
