NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS

First Choice Movers, LLC d/b/a First Choice Movers has filed an application, designated as Docket 15-04025 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to operate as a household goods mover within Clark, Lincoln, and Nye Counties, Nevada.

Isabel Trejo d/b/a Isabel’s Towing has filed an application, designated as Docket 15-04027 with the Authority for a CPCN to provide on-call irregular route transportation of vehicles requiring tow car service by tow car vehicle within the State of Nevada.

C.H. Destinations. Inc. d/b/a Canyon Coach Lines has filed an application, designated as Docket 15-04028 with the Authority for an expansion of authority granted under CPCN 2122. The carrier seeks to add scenic tour service within Clark County, Nevada.

The applications were filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over these matters.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filings may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before May 18, 2015.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s office. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
