The Don Prunty, Greenberg Traurig, LLP Attorneys on behalf of David Jin (deceased) and Yvonne Tang, Trustee, DY Trust (“DYT”) (“Applicants”) have filed a post facto joint application designated as Docket 16-10013 with the Authority for authority by David Jin to sell and transfer and the DYT to purchase and acquire Grand Canyon Development, LLC owner of Y Travel, LLC d/b/a Grand Canyon West Express, a carrier authorized to provide charter bus service within the State of Nevada granted under CPCN 2125.

Yvonne Tang, Trustee, DY Trust (“DYT”) and the Yvonne Tang Survivor’s Trust (“YTST”) (“Applicants”) have filed a post facto joint application designated as Docket 16-10014 with the Authority for authority by the DYT to sell and transfer and the DYT, David Jim Residuary Trust, David Jim Credit Shelter Trust, and Catherin Han to purchase and acquire Grand Canyon Development, LLC owner of Y Travel, LLC d/b/a Grand Canyon West Express, a carrier authorized to provide charter bus service within the State of Nevada granted under CPCN 2125. This application may include tariff modifications.

The applications were filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the NRS and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over these matters.

The applications are on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filings may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before November 18, 2016.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
