NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Envision Healthcare Holdings, Inc. (“EHH”), parent company of American Investment Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a AMR (“AMR”) and Amsurg Corp (“Amsurg”) have filed a joint application designated as Docket 16-12004 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority by EHH to sell and transfer and Amsurg to purchase and acquire AMR through a company merger. AMR is a carrier authorized to provide non-emergency medical transportation within Clark County, Nevada granted under CPCN 1034, Sub 1. This application may include tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s office. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
