NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO EXISTING TARIFFS

Ewing Bros., Inc. d/b/a Ewing Bros. Auto Body, Ewing Bros., Inc. d/b/a Walker Towing, and B & E, Inc., d/b/a SNAP Towing ("Applicants") have filed applications, designated as Docket 17-02001, 17-02002, and 17-02003, respectively, with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") for approval of a tariff modification for services provided under CPCNs 3269, 7023, Sub 2, and 7042, Sub 2, respectively. The Applicants seek modifications, including but not limited to, add a dispatch fee (for law enforcement tows).
