NOTICE OF AMENDED APPLICATION

Anthony Clark and the Clark Legacy Trust (“Trust”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 17-03012 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for Anthony Clark to sell and transfer and the Trust to purchase and acquire 24/7 Entertainment, LLC, a carrier authorized to provide charter limousine service within Clark, Lincoln, and Nye Counties, and charter bus service within the State of Nevada, granted under CPCNs 1102 and 2073, Sub 1, respectively. This application may include tariff modifications.

Anthony Clark and the Clark Legacy Trust (“Trust”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 17-03013 with the Authority for Anthony Clark to sell and transfer and the Trust to purchase and acquire 24/7 Limousines, Ltd, a carrier authorized to provide charter limousine, scenic tour, and special service within the State of Nevada, granted under CPCN 1039, Sub 3. This application may include tariff modifications.

24/7 Limousines, Ltd (“24/7 Ltd.”) has filed an application, designated as Docket 17-03014 with the Authority seeking to expand their fleet for charter limousine, scenic tour, and special services granted under CPCN 1102. The Applicant seeks to increase their current vehicle limitation of from no more than four (4) vehicles to a limit of no more than twelve (12) vehicles in their fleet and to expand to state wide authority. This application may include tariff modifications.

Mark Meyer and Michael Loria have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 17-03018 with the Authority for Mark Meyer to sell and transfer and Michael Loria to purchase and acquire 50% of 1st Response Towing, Inc. d/b/a The Tow Truck Company, a carrier authorized to provide non-consent tow car service within the State of Nevada, granted under CPCN 7136, Sub 3. This application may include tariff modifications.

Mark Meyer and Michael Loria have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 17-03019 with the Authority for Mark Meyer to sell and transfer and Michael Loria to purchase and acquire 50% of 1st Response Towing, Inc., a carrier authorized to provide non-consent tow car service within the State of Nevada, granted under CPCN 7304. This application may include tariff modifications.

The applications were filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over these matters.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filings may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before April 10, 2017.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s office. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
