**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Sierra Nevada Transportation, Inc. ("Sierra") has filed an application designated as Docket 17-01019 with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") for authority to provide charter limousine service within Washoe, Carson City, Douglas, Lyon, Storey, and Churchill Counties Nevada.

The Application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") and the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority to hold a hearing in this matter. Sierra has requested a hearing, and pursuant to applicable sections of NRS 233B, NRS 706, and NAC 706, a Hearing Officer has been designated to conduct the hearing.
