NOTICE OF AMENDED APPLICATION

Spooner Lake, Inc. d/b/a Flume Trail Bikes has filed an amendment to their application, Docket 17-03036, with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to operate a special service shuttle between their bike shop and two trail heads within Washoe, Carson City, and Douglas Counties, Nevada with a fleet restriction of four (4) vehicles.

The amendment was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before June 4, 2018.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s office. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
