CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

The Public Service Commission of Nevada finds that the above-named carrier has complied with this Commission's Compliance Order dated February 27, 1995, the findings of fact and conclusions of law which are hereby incorporated by this reference, and therefore is entitled to receive authority from this Commission to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity CPC A-2441, Sub 1, formerly issued to American Investment Enterprises, Inc. dba NEVADA MEDI-CAR is hereby CANCELED and that in lieu thereof this certificate PSC 1034 is hereby issued to American Investment Enterprises, Inc. dba NEVADA MEDI-CAR.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that American Investment Enterprises, Inc. dba NEVADA MEDI-CAR is hereby granted this certificate of public convenience and necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle subject to applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Commission, and such terms, conditions and limitations as are now or may hereafter be attached to the exercise of the privileges herein granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED and made a condition of this certificate that the holder shall render reasonably continuous and adequate service to the public in pursuance of the authority herein granted, and that failure to do so shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension, modification or revocation of this certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing contained herein shall be construed to be either a franchise or irrevocable and that failure to comply with rules, regulations and orders of the Commission and applicable statutory provisions shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension or revocation of this certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authority shall not be sold or transferred without the Commission's prior approval.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the transportation service to be performed by said carrier shall be as specified below:

Irregular route transportation by motor vehicle of wheelchair patients, convalescents, infirm and handicapped people requiring special transportation and elderly people requiring special transportation and elderly individuals in non-emergency service;

Between points and places within Clark County, Nevada, on the one hand, and between points and places within the State of Nevada on the other.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission retains jurisdiction for the purpose of correcting any errors which may have occurred in the drafting or issuance of this Order and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.
