CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Bour Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Stardust Transportation CPCN 1017, Sub 5 Docket No. 16-01017

The Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") finds that the above-named carrier has complied with this Authority's Amended Compliance Order dated June 16, 2017, the findings of fact and conclusions of law which are hereby incorporated by this reference, and therefore is entitled to receive authority from this Authority to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS ORDERED that certificate of public convenience and necessity identified as CPCN 1017, Sub 4, is hereby cancelled and Bour Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Stardust Transportation is hereby granted this certificate of public convenience and necessity, identified as CPCN 1017, Sub 5, as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle subject to applicable statutes, rules and regulations of the Authority, and such terms, conditions and limitations as are now or may hereafter be attached to the exercise of the privileges herein granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED and made a condition of this certificate that the holder shall render reasonably continuous and adequate service to the public in pursuance of the authority herein granted, and that failure to do so shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension, modification or revocation of this certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing contained herein shall be construed to be either a franchise or irrevocable and that failure to comply with rules, regulations and orders of the Authority and applicable statutory provisions shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension or revocation of this certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authority shall not be sold or transferred without the Authority's prior approval.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the transportation service to be performed by said carrier shall be as specified below:

- On-call irregular route transportation of passengers and their baggage by charter limousine between points and places within Clark and Nye Counties, Nevada.
- Transportation of passengers and their baggage on a per capita basis (with a minimum charge for each point-to-point trip) by traditional limousine, on-call over irregular routes between points and places (from casino-to-casino) in the geographic area known as "the Laughlin Strip" (Casino Drive), Laughlin, Nevada.

Restrictions:

The carrier shall operate no more than fourteen (14) vehicles, with no more than five (5) of the fourteen (14) vehicles providing point-to-point service in the Las Vegas Metropolitan area. The carrier shall specifically designate the five (5) vehicles to be operated in the Las Vegas Metropolitan area by Vehicle Identification Number ("VIN"), and shall submit the aforementioned VIN numbers to the Nevada Transportation Authority for approval before the vehicles may operate (in providing point-to-point service) in the Las Vegas Metropolitan area. (The carrier may continue to operate under Stardust Limousine, Inc. in their Laughlin, Nevada area operations.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Authority retains jurisdiction for the purpose of correcting any errors which may have occurred in the drafting or issuance of this Order and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.
