

ORDER
and
CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

EWING BROS., INC. dba
EWING BROS. AUTO BODY

CPC A-3269
(formerly CPC A-2139, Sub 1)

At a general session of the Public Service Commission of Nevada, held at its offices in Carson City, Nevada, December 15, 1981.

After due investigation, it appearing that the above-named carrier has complied with this Commission's Compliance Order dated December 19, 1980 and therefore is entitled to receive authority from this Commission to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a motor carrier; and the Commission having ordered that upon full compliance with the above-mentioned Compliance Order certificate CPC A-2139, Sub 1 should be cancelled,

IT IS ORDERED on the Commission's own motion, that certificate of public convenience and necessity CPC A-2139, Sub 1 formerly issued to Rex C. Ewing, Jr. dba Ewing Bros. Auto Body shall be, and the same is hereby, CANCELLED; that in lieu thereof, this certificate (i.e. CPC A-3269) shall be, and the same is hereby, issued to Ewing Bros., Inc. dba Ewing Bros. Auto Body; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the said carrier be, and it is hereby, granted this certificate of public convenience and necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle, subject, however, to the Motor Carrier Act and rules and regulations of the Commission, and such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges herein granted to the said carrier; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, and is made a condition of this certificate, that the holder thereof shall render reasonably continuous and adequate service to the public in pursuance of the authority herein granted, and that failure so to do shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension, change or revocation of this certificate; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That nothing contained herein shall be construed to be either a franchise or irrevocable; and that the failure to comply with the rules and regulations and/or orders of the Commission or statutory provisions shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension or revocation of this certificate; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this certificate shall not be sold or transferred without having obtained prior authority from the Commission; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this certificate is RESTRICTED to transportation in intrastate commerce ONLY; and said certificate is explicitly RESTRICTED against registration with the Interstate Commerce Commission under Section 206 (a) (6) of the Interstate Commerce Act, the Commission having made no investigation nor finding that the public convenience and necessity requires this transportation service in interstate commerce; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the transportation service to be performed by said carrier shall be as specified below:

- (1) Transportation in tow car service of wrecked or disabled vehicles, including wrecked or disabled mobile homes, with tow car vehicle grossing an unladen weight of 9,000 lbs. or more

Between points and places in Clark, Lincoln, Nye, and those portions of Mineral and Esmeralda Counties lying on and south of U.S. 6

Between Las Vegas and points and places in Nevada.


- (2) Transportation in tow car service of wrecked or disabled vehicles with tow car vehicle grossing an unladen weight of less than 9,000 lbs.

Between points and places within a twenty (20)
mile radius of Las Vegas, Nevada; and


Between points and places within a twenty (20)
mile radius of Las Vegas, Nevada on the one hand
and points and places within a one hundred seventy-five
(175) mile radius on the other.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Commission retains jurisdiction in the
premises for the purpose of correcting any errors which may have occurred in
the drafting of this Certificate and Order.
