or paid by established accounts within 30 days of service. Charges for services in addition to the services
ordered and previously prepaid shall be paid within 24 hours of presentation of invoice or transportation
bill to the debtor.

CHARTER OPERATIONS shall be conducted under charges as provided in Rates & Charges Section of this tariff.

BAGGAGE

5

Hand baggage, not to exceed one hundred (100) pounds in weight for each fare ticket will be carried
without charge. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable
for or damage to baggage or contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of reasonable care on its part
and then only for the maximum liability of \$250.00 for the loss of, or damage to, any single piece of
baggage, including its contents.

LIABILITY

10 The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine riots, strikes, force majeure, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the roads, storms and other conditions beyond its control; and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a special time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employee; and, over routes indicated, but the same is not guaranteed.

If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigations, riots, strikes, hazards or dangers incident to the state of war, accident, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from the point of origin or any point en route, the carrier will not be held for damages for any reasons whatsoever.

15 CLAIMS

A Claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall (a) Compensate the shipper or Consignor; or (b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the Shipper or consignor to the Nevada Transportation Authority.

20 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

The driver of the transit vehicle will have the right to refuse to carry any person or require any passenger to leave the vehicle if the person or passenger is intoxicated, unruly or who is believed to be under the influence of narcotics.

25 ANIMALS

Animals, other than 'Seeing Eye Dogs' will not be carried unless properly confined.

AGENT

Carrier may elect to appoint any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel, or legal gaming operation, who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or common points for the collection of all applicable charges and remittance thereof direct to carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier.

CANCELLATION NOTICE

The cancellation of all vehicles will be assessed a cancellation fee. A cancellation between 24 hours to 5 days prior to departure, the fee will be \$100.00. In the event that the request for transportation is canceled less than twenty-four (24) hours from the time of cancellation notification to the time of requested service, the fee shall be equal to 20% of the service originally requested. If the equipment has already arrived at the departure destination and there is a request for cancellation, the fee will be equal to 100% of the service originally requested.

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CHARGES & ON-CALL SERVICES – RATES & CHARGES

CHARTER BUS SERVICES

- Note 1: Airport vehicle search fee: A fee of \$3.00 per vehicle per security check will apply to all charter service where the carrier is required to pay an airport vehicle search fee to the Clark County Department of Aviation.
- Note 2: Airport parking-toll fee: A fee of \$10.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service where the carrier is required to pay an airport parking fee to the Clark County Department of Aviation.
- Note 3: Airport assistance fee (Meet and Greet): A fee of \$10.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service where the driver is required to meet passengers inside the airport to assist them with their luggage and escort them to their vehicle.
- Note 4: Amenities Fee: A fee of \$20.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service will be at cost plus the cost of the amenity.
- Note 5: Charges & on-call services rates & charges
- A. The charges shown below are for charter and cover continuous transportation as well as the time the vehicle is rented and reserved for passenger use, preventing use for other client's transportation.
 - B. All transportation requires one hour minimum with half hour increase thereafter, except for:
 - Airport pickup and drop-offs are one and ½ minimum
 - Federal and State holidays are 3 hour minimums
 - Special events such as prom, homecoming, school dances are 6 hour minimums
 - Nascar is 10 hours minimum
 - CES and CON Expo is 12 hours minimum
 - C. Bookings will be charged in half hour increments after the first full hour of service. Any rate charged for any charter, whether generated as an "on-call" booking, call rate booking, or any other charter, automatically includes all the functional features of the particular vehicle, such as the stereo, television, DVD player, ambient lights, ice service, etc. The hourly charge for any vehicle is per hour plus surcharges and amenities.
 - D. All rates are inclusive of accompanying staff, unless special arrangements for accompanying staff are made. "I.E. VIP host, tour guide, greeters, models, interpreter, security or body guard, etc." Added amenities are at cost plus \$20.00 per amenity, "I.E. flowers, balloons, birthday gifts, cards, cameras, fruit baskets, non-alcoholic beverages, mixers, juices, club soda, bottled water, special event tickets, catering services, meals, video/DVD rentals, karaoke machines, Xbox rentals, video games, luggage vehicles or trailers, child car seat, wheelchair, etc." All amenities are based upon availability. Some amenity items will require advanced arrangements.
 - E. Applicable for all charter bus vehicles additional charges shall apply for the following damages: Cigarette burns: \$500.00, Biohazard fee "sickness in vehicles" 3X charter bus hourly rate, broken/missing glasses: \$5.00 each, broken/missing exit handle: \$350.00, smoking fine: \$100.00.
 - F. There are no prices based on a quote "per person" bases. All prices are based on a "total vehicle" hourly rate price. Any toll charges, parking or other trip fees and/or park entrance fees are the responsibilities of the client/customer.
 - G. As previously stated, the following price table represents all the rates for any and all charter and/or on-call service rates.

CANCELLATION CHARGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 50

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FUEL SURCHARGE TABLE AND RULES

The following Fuel Surcharge Rules will apply to carriers who are authorized to provide charter service by bus and who are authorized to charge and collect a fuel surcharge.

1. The price of regular and diesel fuel is an amount equal to the retail price per gallon of regular and diesel fuel effective for the 25th calendar date of the immediately preceding month determined according to the United States Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey on Weekly Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices, Regular Grade – West Coast (PADD 5). The prices may be obtained by calling the DOE, EIA at (202) 586-8800 or via the DOE, EIA website at www.cia.doe.gov, via the petroleum link.
2. If the 25th of the calendar month is a Federal holiday, the fuel price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
3. The DOE fuel price obtained will then be indexed based on the matrix set forth below to determine the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharge will apply for all charter bus transportation beginning on the 1st day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
4. The fuel surcharge will be added on an hourly basis utilizing the matrix set forth below. The resulting charge is in addition to all other applicable transportation charges.

Note 1: The fuel surcharge that is applicable for a given month must be passed along to all customers.

Note 2: The fuel surcharge must be shown separately from the charter revenue on carrier transportation documents for the purpose of identifying the amount as special fuel-related revenue.

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
