APPLICATION OF CARRIERS OPERATING AUTHORITY

Fares and charges in this tariff are limited in their application to the extent of carriers operating authority set forth in a certificate, issued by the Nevada Transportation Authority, RESTRICTED to transportation in INTRASTATE Commerce only as a common carrier by motor vehicle, as follows:

ELKO, INC. - CPCN 2121, Sub 1

On call over irregular routes of, passengers in Charter Bus Services, between points and places in the State of Nevada.

ITEM RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICATION OF TARIFF

10 Fares and charges names in this tariff are stated in gross (commissionable) terms: and cover only ground transportation of passengers and their baggage, as provided in Carrier's Operations Authority in charter service operations. Rates and charges provided in this tariff, for services ordered, shall be paid under the terms agreed upon between the customer and the company.

BAGGAGE

20 Hand baggage, not to exceed one hundred (100) pounds in weight will be carried during the charter service ordered. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or baggage contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of reasonable care on its part and then only for the maximum liability of \$250.00 for the loss of, or damage to, any single piece of baggage, including its contents.

**ITEM** **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

---

**LIABILITY**

30 The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, force majeure, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms, and other conditions beyond its control; and, does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by the customer: and over routes indicated, but the same to not guaranteed.

If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to the state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms, and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from the point of origin or any other point enroute, the carrier shall not be liable therefor, or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

ITEM RULES AND REGULATIONS

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

50 The driver of the motorcoach vehicle shall have the right to refuse to carry any person or require any passenger to leave the vehicle if the person or passenger is intoxicated, unruly or who is believed to in under the influence of narcotics.

ANIMALS

60 Animals, other than "Seeing Eye Dogs" or "companion animals" as defined in the ADA regulations, will not be carried unless properly confined. All companion animals must be kept under control at all times.

PASSENGER AGENT

70 Carrier may elect to appoint as its agent any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel, or legal gaming operation, who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or more common points for the collection of all applicable charges and remittance thereof direct to carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier.

CANCELLATION POLICY

80 Carrier reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee in the event that the request for transportation is cancelled less than 24 hours from the time of cancellation notification to time of requested service. This fee will be \$250.00 unless request is cancelled after equipment has already arrived at the departure destination. Such fee shall then be the minimum charge for transportation services.
