RULES AND REGULATIONS

APPLICATION OF TARIFF

Fares and charges named in this tariff are stated in gross (commissionable) terms; and cover only ground transportation of passengers and their baggage, as provided in Carrier's Operating Authority in transportation operations. Rates and charges provided.

APPLICATION OF CARRIERS OPERATING AUTHORITY

Fares and charges in this tariff are limited in their application to the extent of carrier's operating authority set forth in certificate, issued by the Transportation Services Authority of Nevada, RESTRICTED to transportation in INTRASTATE Commerce only as a common carrier by motor vehicle, as follows:

A On Call over irregular routes, of Passengers in charter limousine service, between points and within the State of Nevada.

In this tariff, for services as ordered, shall be prepaid or paid by established accounts within 30 days of service. Charges for services in addition to the services ordered and previously prepaid shall be paid within 24 hours of presentation of invoice or transportation bill to the debtor.

APPLICATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

Waiting time and deadhead time: Rates and charges named in this tariff are applicable to waiting time, live service and deadhead time (i.e., required travel time of the vehicle without passengers between the point of dispatch and the point of passenger pick-up/drop-off), except that there will be no charge for deadhead time for transportation provided entirely within the area of the Las Vegas Valley bounded by Washington Ave. to the north, Pecos Rd. to the east, Windmill Pkwy. to the south and Rainbow Blvd. to the west

Commission or referral fee: The carrier at its sole option may pay a commission or referral fee to a travel agent, tour broker, tour operator or hotel casino who arranges for the provision of transportation by the carrier to a third party, so long as the commission or referral fee does not exceed 10% of the applicable rate or charge specified in this tariff for the transportation provided.

CHARTER OPERATIONS shall be conducted under charges as provided in Section I of this tariff.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM

LIABILITY

The carrier will not be liable for delays 'caused by an act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, force majeure, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms and other conditions beyond its control; and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employee; and, over routes indicated, but the same is not guaranteed.

BAGGAGE

Hand baggage, not to exceed forty (40) pounds in weight for each fare ticket will be carried without charge. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of reasonable care on its part and then only for the maximum liability of \$25.00 for the loss of, or damage to, any single piece of baggage, including its contents. Client may request luggage vehicle at tariff rate. No tools or articles with sharp edges will be carried, unless securely and safely packaged. No explosives, inflammables or liquids which could contaminate or be harmful to passengers or equipment will be carried.

CLAIMS

A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. 60

Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall:

- (a) Compensate the shipper or consignor: or
- (b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim

3. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Authority.

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

Carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person under the influence of intoxicants or drugs, or incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or when conduct is likely to objectionable to other passengers or prospective passengers. This rule does not apply to persons who are ill or incapacitated and are accompanied by an attendant or nurse. 70

ANIMALS

Dogs, cats or other live animals will not be carried unless properly confined in an approved carrier. 80

CAR DAMAGE AND CLEAN-UP FEE

The customer will be charged the actual cost: 1) to repair damage to the vehicle caused by the passenger's intentional acts of negligence; or where special cleaning beyond the carrier's normal procedures is required because of the passenger's intentional acts or negligence. 90
