Rule No. Rules & Regulations

Rule #1. Classic Firetruck Rides will operate from 12 noon to 6:00 pm seven days a week for rides up and down the strip. Rides will last at least 15 minutes. Charter events may be scheduled via telephone or walk up to take place between 6:00 pm and 12:00 midnight.

Rule #2. Riders may ask questions about the firetruck, but this is not a "tour" and the operator will not announce points of interest.

Rule #3. Infants under the age of 1 are free to ride in a car safety seat with an adult. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or adult accompany them.

Rule #4. Riders must follow the directions of the operator. Riders must stay seated with seat belts on during the ride. If an emergency for the rider occurs, they are to notify the operator immediately.

Rule #5. Carrier will not refuse service because of a person's race, creed, color, sex, or national origin.

Rule #6. Carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person who appears to be under the influence of intoxicants or drugs or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself or whose conduct is likely to disrupt the safety or enjoyment of other passengers.

Rule #7. Riders will be allowed to carry normal shopping bags (maximum of 2 bags). Suitcases and other bulky items will be discouraged as they may pose a danger to other riders.

Rule #8. Carrier is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Carrier will collect anything left on the firetruck and package it with time and date in an effort to have the item returned to the owner.

Rule #9. A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damage freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier with 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall: (a) Compensate the shipper or consignor; or (b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Authority.

Rule No. Rules & Regulations

Rule #10. Each ride costs \$10 per person. State and local taxes are included in \$10 ticket cost. Charter events after regular hours will be charged \$150 per hour plus state and local taxes with a minimum \$300 charge. Charter events must be prepaid by the day of the event or the event will be canceled.

Rule #11. Service animals are welcome on Classic Firetruck Rides.

Rule #12. Carrier will accept payment in the form of cash and credit cards.

Rule #13. The ride will begin at 3131 South Las Vegas Blvd and continue 4 miles on Las Vegas Blvd, then return to starting point.

Rule #14. This is a walk-up type business. If the rider changes their mind before the ride begins, his/her money will be refunded in full. If there is weather or a mechanical issue, carrier will offer refunds or rides at a later date. There must be at least 3 riders before the firetruck will begin the ride.

Charter Service:

Charter events after regular hours (between 6:00 pm and midnight) will be charged \$150 per hour and include state and local taxes with a minimum \$300 charge. Charter events must be prepaid by the day of the event or the event will be cancelled.
