5. Application of Tariff

Operate as a passenger carrier to provide intrastate charter bus service between points and places within the State of Nevada.

10. Computation of Rates and Charges

Rates and charges named within this tariff are applicable to waiting time and live services, and apply from scheduled time of pick up until the time of drop off.

15. Minimum Charges

The minimum charges for charter services will be one hour. Driver gratuity is not included. A 5% charge will be incurred if paying with a debit card or a credit card, or a 10% surcharge if paying with multiple cards.

20. Baggage

(a) Baggage is limited to handbags only. If the charter is an overnight stay or an airport pickup/departure baggage can be up to forty pounds per person.

(b) No harmful materials such as but not limited to: Explosives, Flammable items, Harmful liquids, or anything deemed dangerous will be allowed.

(c) Weapons will not be allowed on the charter bus unless the individual holds a special permit and management prior to the charter service has approved it. This person will not be allowed to consume any alcoholic beverages while in possession of said permitted weapon.

25. Liability for Baggage and/or Personal Belongings/Valuables

Carrier is not liable for loss or damaged baggage or its contents, unless there was a lack of reasonable care on the carrier's behalf. Personal valuables should not be stored on the charter or away from the individual to whom it belongs. The maximum liability for the carrier from any person is \$250.

30. Claims

NAC 706.333 claims for any lost or damaged freight or baggage. (NRS 706.171)

1. A claim by a shipper or consigner against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within seven days after the loss or damages discovered
2. Within fourteen days after the receipt of the claim, a carrier shall:
 - (a) Compensate the shipper or consigner; or
 - (b) Deliver to the shipper or consigner a written denial of the claim.
3. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consigner to the Authority.

35. Animals/Pets

No animals or pets are allowed on the carrier unless:

1. They are a working seeing-eye dog for the blind

40. Rights of Service

The carrier reserves the right to deny any service to individuals or groups that (but not limited to)

1. Are under the influence of intoxicating/controlled substances and unable to take care of themselves
2. Are rude, disrespectful to equipment, staff or other people on or off the charter
3. Are not obeying laws, rules or regulations.

45. Cancellations

A notice of cancelation of chartered services, under reservations, must be given 72 hours in advance or more (a \$25 processing will be incurred upon any cancellation). Cancellations given within 72 hours will cause forfeiture of the entire deposit that was given and the remaining balance will be charged in full.

50. Commissions

The carrier may give a commission to an agent that has arranged the charter for the carrier with a client. Such a commission shall be 10% of the total charter rate.

55. Smoking

Smoking of any kind will not be permitted in any of the carrier's vehicles.

60. Damages to or on a Charter Vehicle

Any damages caused by any individual on the chartered vehicle, will be charged to the person reserving the charter service. This includes but is not limited to:

1. Anything broken, stolen or missing
2. Being left in a dirty state of condition, or;
3. Any bodily fluids or solids

65. Carrier Liability

The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an Act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, force majeure, accidents, breakdowns, bad road conditions, storms or other beyond its control; and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employee; and, over routes indicated, the same is not guaranteed.

If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to the state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms, and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from the point or origin or any point en route, the carrier will not be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

70. Non-Discriminating

Carrier will not refuse service to anyone because of race, creed, sex or national origin.

75. Children – Unaccompanied

No person under the age of 18 will permitted to take part in service, unless a parent, guardian, or other responsible adult accompanies the minor(s). We define an adult as any person over the age of 18 and who is responsible for the care and supervision of the child(ren). In the special event such as Homecoming, Prom, School Dances, School Events etc. where an adult might not be present during the complete duration of the charter service, an adult must be present at the time of pickup/drop off, also in this special circumstance, all passengers under the age of 18 must have a parental consent/release form filled out, signed and completed in full before scheduled time of pickup. The carrier will not tolerate or permit any person under the age of 21 to be deemed intoxicated or under the influence by any means and if found to be in this state, carrier reserves the right to terminate charter service at that point without refund or liability.

80. Children’s Fares

No child will have a reduced rate. No child will be allowed to sit in anyone’s lap and children who require infant seats or child safety seats will be allowed in the provision that a responsible adult provides such a seat and installs the seat in the vehicle securing with the vehicle’s safety belts.

85. Passenger Agent

Carrier may elect to appoint as its agent any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel, or legal gaming operation, who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or more common points for the collection of all applicable charges and remittance there of directly to carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier.

Charges shown in this section for Charter services cover continuous or round trip transportation only from point of origin in Nevada and return thereto.

Charter services will be conducted over paved, oil macadam roads, or roads which the carrier's equipment can be operated with safety and without undue wear.

Charter Services Rates and Charges

The charges shown on page 8 are for Charter Services, and cover continuous transportation, as well as the time the vehicle is rented and reserved for passenger use, preventing use for another client's transportation. The standard booking time for any vehicle is at least (1) hour. Booking price will be charged in hourly booking increments after the minimum is met.

All rates are exclusive of accompanying staff, unless special arrangements for accompanying staff are made, (i.e. **VIP Hosts, greeters, models, interpreter, security, bodyguard etc.**) Added amenities, not already included with any vehicle, (i.e., **flowers, balloons, gifts, beverages, special event tickets, catering, video games, luggage vehicle or car etc.**) will be charged the rate in which the carrier is charged for the amenity plus a booking and/or staff fee of \$25 per amenity.

**Pricing Schedule
(Per Hour Charter Rates)**

Rates listed are per hour and subject to the conditions mentioned before.

Domestic or import, luxury Bus, or Charter Bus with a passenger capacity from 16-32 including driver:

Sunday – Thursday: \$135 per Hour Friday-Saturday \$155 per Hour

All rates include excise tax and fuel surcharge.

Maximum driving time allowed by law is 10 hours per day, during any shift of up to 12 hours. Therefore, any long-distance round trip over 5 hours driving one way, requires an overnight stay at the turning point, making the trip a two-day excursion.

Per Diem of \$100 plus \$35.00 per hour waiting time will be charged in lieu of driver lodging and meal expenses for trips lasting 10 hours or more. Driver gratuities are not included. Any toll, parking or other trip fees, park entrance fees, are responsibilities of the customer.

High Society Bus Company LLC will always attempt to adhere to time schedules specified by customers, and will not be held liable for any damages from delays caused by Acts of God, public enemies, authority of law, storms, and any other conditions beyond its control. High Society Bus Company LLC shall not be held liable for any damages caused by delays specified herein.

Additional Charges

Charge if Charter Bus is left in excess of not being clean

\$50 per hour for excess cleaning plus
Actual costs for any materials, professional cleaning service, or services.

If the Charter Bus Vehicle is not able to make it to its next scheduled charter, then all costs associated with the missed charter/time will also apply.

Bodily Fluids/Hazmat clean up such as but not limited to:

1. Urine
2. Bowels
3. Blood
4. Vomit

Will incur an additional Hazmat cleaning fee of \$500.

Actual costs of materials and repairs from damage or theft will be the responsibility of the main person that has reserved the charter service.

Smoking is not permitted in any of the carrier's vehicles at any time, and should this occur, there will be a \$100 smoking fine and/or a \$600 fee for any burns or damages to vehicles caused by smoking.

Any vehicle supplied amenities such as broken or missing decanters, glassware, IPOD connectors, Android connectors, music DVD's etc, will incur a restocking fine of \$20, plus actual cost of item per item that is broken or missing.
