APPLICATON OF TARIFF

3:

Rules, regulations, rates and charges named in this tariff apply to the transportation of passengers and their baggage in charter bus service, including driver, between points and places in Nevada.

COMPUTATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

6:

Rates and charges named in this tariff are applicable to waiting time, deadhead and live service, and apply from the time the coach is dispatched until it returns to point of dispatch.

BAGGAGE

9:

- (A) Hand baggage not to exceed thirty (30) pounds per adult passenger
- (B) No tools or articles with sharp edges will be carried.
- (C) No explosives, inflammable or liquids, which could contaminate or be harmful to passengers or equipment, will be carried.

ANIMALS

12: Dogs, cats or other live animals will not be carried unless properly confined in a proper container.

Exception: Seeing Eye dogs in the performance of their duty guiding blind persons and assistance dogs with proper documentation.

Rule No

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

15:

Carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person under the influence of intoxicants or drugs, or incapable of taking care of himself, or when conduct is likely to be objectionable to other passengers or prospective passengers. This rule does not apply to persons who are ill or incapacitated and are accompanied by an attendant.

CARRIER LIABILITY

18:

Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or the contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of care on its part, and then only for the reasonable value thereof, subject to a maximum liability of \$225.00 for the loss of, or damage to, any single piece of baggage, including its contents.

CLAIMS

21:

- (1) A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract carrier for lost or damaged baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered.
- (2) Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall:
 - (a) Compensate shipper or consignor or
 - (b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim.
- (3) A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Authority.

RATES AND CHARGES

- (1) Vehicles with a seating capacity of 16-29 passengers / one hour minimum transfer rate, from McCarran International Airport to any hotel located on Las Vegas Boulevard between the Plaza Hotel and Casino and Mandalay Bay.
\$75.00 per hour.
- (2) Vehicles with a seating capacity of 16-29 passengers for locations other than what is described on #1 above, minimum charge three hours for \$225.00. Each additional hour. \$75.00
- (3) Vehicles with a seating capacity of 50 plus passengers 1 hour minimum Charge \$230.00 per hour from McCarran International Airport to any hotel located on Las Vegas Boulevard between the Plaza Hotel and Casino and Mandalay Bay.
- (4) Vehicles with a seating capacity of 50 plus passengers for locations other than what is described on #3 above. Minimum charge, three hours for \$340.00 each additional hour \$95.00.

10% discount to frequent Customers. Frequent customers consist of any client who provides a minimum of \$8,000 of business in a prior immediate calendar year.

Fuel Surcharge see page 6.

Cancellation less than 24 hours prior to departure will be charged 100% of fee.

Passenger count does not include driver.

FUEL SURCHARGE

Fuel Cost Price Adjustment (Surcharge)

The following Fuel-Related Cost Price Adjustment (Surcharge) will apply on passenger transportation charges, as described below.

1. On the 25th day of each calendar month, the price per gallon of gasoline will be determined based on the price stated by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration's (EIA) survey on "Retail On-highway Gasoline Prices- West Coast Average". This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hotline at (202) 586-6966 or via the DOE Internet web site at www.eia.doe.gov
2. If the 25th day of the calendar month is a Federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
3. The DOE fuel price obtained will then be indexed based on the fuel price adjustment factor matrix set forth in this item to determine the Fuel Cost Price Adjustment that will become applicable on the 1st day of the month. The adjustment determined will apply for all transportation beginning on the 1st day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
4. The surcharge will be added on an hourly basis utilizing the matrix set forth below. The resulting charge is in addition to all other applicable transportation charges.

When the DOE Fuel Price Per Gallon reported on the 25 th of the month is:	The Fuel Cost Adjustment Factor that becomes effective on the 1 st day of the following month is:

NOTE 1: The fuel surcharge, if applicable for a given month, must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The Fuel Cost Price Adjustment will be shown separately from the charter revenue on carrier transportation documents for the purpose of identifying the amount as special fuel-related revenue.

3% TAX Pursuant to SECTION 51 of AB175

The following rules apply to carriers who provide passenger transportation, excluding Airport transport service:

Pursuant to Nevada Legislative Senate Bill No.376

Sec.36. Section 51 of Assembly Bill No.175 of this session is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec.51. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a common motor carrier of a passenger to a person or operator willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department of Taxation shall charge and collect from each common motor carrier of passengers the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to an airport transfer service

3. (Intentionally omitted)

4. As used in this section, "airport transfer service" means the transportation of passengers and their baggage in the same vehicle except by taxicab, for a per capita charge between airport or between an airport and points and places in this State. The term does not include charter services by bus, charter services by limousine, scenic tours or special service.

NOTE 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.

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
