Service Description

U-Haul Co. of Nevada Inc operates as an Intrastate Carrier of household goods between points and places within Clark County, Nye, and Lincoln Counties on the one hand and points and places within the State of Nevada on the other hand. The service provided to the general public will be portable storage. By renting portable storage containers the public will be able to store and move their belongings without having to leave their house. The containers are delivered to the customers desired location. The customer keeps their container until use of container is no longer desired. Customers have the option for either storage at their location or at the secure warehouse. All containers will be transported with a straight truck.

Claims and Liability Coverage

CLAIMS FOR LOST OR DAMAGED FREIGHT OR BAGGAGE

1. A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered.
2. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall:
 - (a) Compensate the shipper or consignor; or
 - (b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim.
3. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Authority.

NOTIFICATION OF LIABILITY COVERAGE

Before providing any service subject to regulation by the Nevada Transportation Authority, a carrier of household goods must notify the customer in writing of the scope of the standard liability coverage provided and the availability of additional coverage.

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Household Goods Tariff No. 1
Bill for Payment

BILL FOR PAYMENT

1. Upon the completion of a shipment of household goods, the authorized carrier shall present to the person paying for the shipment the original bill for payment.

2. The bill must show:

- (a) The name and address of the carrier.
- (b) The names of the consignor and consignee.
- (c) The points of origin and destination.
- (d) The date and time the shipment was received by the carrier.
- (e) The date and time of arrival of the shipment at its destination.
- (f) The date of the bill.
- (g) The weight of the shipment, if applicable.
- (h) The route over which the household goods were transported, the name of the point of transfer and the name of each carrier participating in the transportation.
- (i) The numbers of the vehicles which transported the household goods.
- (j) An adequate description of the property transported
- (k) The rate charged for the service.
- (l) Any other charge incident to the transportation.
- (m) A statement that the carrier's rates are subject to regulation by the Nevada Transportation Authority.
- (n) Any other information required by the Nevada Transportation Authority.

 Rates and Charges

Rental of a portable storage container is charged on a monthly basis. The monthly rental rate for (1) storage unit is \$59.95.

Delivery of the portable storage container, either full or empty, is based on proximity to the warehouse. If the delivery point is within 25 miles of the warehouse the delivery fee is \$99.00.

Local moves, whereby a container is picked up from a customer's location and delivered directly to another location, other than the warehouse, are subject to delivery fees. If the new delivery point is within 25 miles of the warehouse, the delivery will cost \$99.00

There is no charge for pick up of full or empty containers taken to the warehouse.

Locations outside the 25 mile radius of the warehouse but within the standard service radius of 65 miles will be charged an additional \$1per mile.

Locations between 65 and 80 miles from the warehouse will be billed a flat fee of \$200.

Locations between 80 miles and 105 miles will be billed a flat fee of \$400.
