5 APPLICATION OF TARIFF

Carrier operates an on-call commercial transportation company, over irregular routes using charter bus to provide intrastate passenger transportation in the form of charter bus service from points and places within the State of Nevada.

10 COMPUTATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

Rates and charges are identified herein and pertain specifically to charter bus services provided by charter on an hourly basis consistent with the authorized authority as granted by the Nevada Transportation Authority.

15 BAGGAGE

- a) Hand baggage shall not exceed forty (40) pounds per each bag per adult passenger;
- b) Articles with sharp edges will not be carried unless securely and safely packaged;
- c) Explosives, inflammables, or harmful liquids will not be transported.

25 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

Carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person under the influence of intoxicants or drugs, or incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or whose conduct is likely to be objectionable to other passengers.

Exception: Incapacitated or ill persons accompanied by a nurse or guardian.

30 LIABILITY

Pursuant to NAC 706.333, a claim by a shipper or consignor against a common motor carrier for lost or damaged freight Or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. Thereafter, within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall either: (a) compensate the shipper or consignor; or (b) deliver to the Shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the NTA.

Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or their contents, unless such loss or damage is caused by lack of responsible care, and then only for the reasonable value thereof, subject to a maximum liability to \$250.00 for the Loss of, or damage to, any single piece of baggage, including contents.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY

Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an Act of God, Public Enemies, Authority if Law, Quarantine, Riots, Strikes, Accidents, Breakdowns, Highway Conditions or any other condition beyond its control and does not guarantee arrival or departure time from any given point at any specified time. However, the carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by the contracting party but the same is not guaranteed.

If in the opinion of the carrier, an act of God, Public Enemies, Authority of Law, Quarantine, Riots, Strikes, Accidents, Breakdowns, Highway Conditions or any other condition beyond its control, makes it inadvisable to operate its equipment from the point of origin or any point enroute, the carrier shall not be liable therefore or be caused to be held for damages for any reasons whatsoever.

Carrier Underground Promotions will not be held liable or responsible for personal articles lost, stolen from passengers or left in the equipment/vehicle.

50 CANCELLATION

All cancellation fees and timelines are to be identified by the carrier on each charter contract and adhered to per that contract. Carrier reserves the right to collect the penalties as outlined on such contracts.

Underground Promotions LLC, will charge a cancellation fee of 50% of the total amount in the event that the request for transportation is canceled less than 7 days from the time of cancellation notification to the time of requested service. Cancellation with less forty-eight (48) hours' notice will be charged the full amount of the charter order. All refunds are subject to a 5% processing fee and will only be returned to one credit card or issued in the form of a check.

The carrier reserves the right to cancel any service because of weather or other conditions such as road hazards due to slides, storms, or other similar causes, natural, or otherwise which makes travel inadvisable.

Any amenities booked must be prepaid in advance; the customer is responsible for any fees incurred for cancelling any booked amenities (regardless of time frame- i.e. if client requests tickets to a show and then cancels the reservation then they will still be charged for the tickets since that is something that is nonrefundable).

Note 3: Airport Assistance Fee (Meet & Greet): A fee of \$10.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service where the driver is required to meet passengers inside the airport to assist them with their luggage and escort them to the Vehicle.

Note 4: Amenities Fee: A fee of \$20.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service will be at cost plus the cost of the amenity, subject to availability and/or advanced arrangement.

Note 5: Charter & On-Call Service Rates & Charges

- a. The charges shown below are for Charter, and/or On-Call, and/or Walk-On Services and cover continuous transportation. As well as the time the vehicle is rented and reserved for passenger use, preventing use for other client's transportation.
- b. All transportation requires one hour minimum with half hour increase thereafter, except for:
 - Airport pickups and drop offs are one and ½ hour minimum
 - Federal and State Holidays is 3 hours minimum
 - Special events such as prom, homecomings, school dances are 6 hours minimum
 - NASCAR is 10 hours minimum
 - CES and CONEXPO is 12 hours minimum
- c. Bookings will be charge in half hour increments after the first full hour of service. Any rate change for any Charter, whether generated as on "On-Call" booking, or as a "Walk-On Rate" booking, or any other Charter, automatically includes all the functional features of the particular vehicle, such as a stereo, television, DVD player, ambient lights, ice service, etc. The hourly charge for any vehicle per hour, plus fuel surcharges and amenities.
- d. All rates are exclusive of accompanying staff, unless special arrangements for accompanying staff are made, (i.e. VIP Host, greeters, models, interpreter, security or bodyguard, etc.)
- e. Applicable for all Charter Bus vehicles Additional charges shall apply for the following damages: Cigarette Burns: \$600, Biohazard fee (sickness, blood, bodily fluid, etc.) 3X Charter Bus hourly rate, Smoking fine: \$100. Any vehicle supplied amenities such as broken or missing decanters, glassware, Ipod connectors, music DVD's, etc. will incur a restocking fine of \$20.00, plus actual cost of item per item that is broken or missing.

CHARGES & ON-CALL SERVICES – RATES & CHARGES

Any damage to the emergency windows, Audio/Visual Equipment, lighting System or partition, will result in the cost to repair or replace these items. In addition, if the Charter Bus vehicle is not able to make its next scheduled charter due to the damages caused, all costs associated with that missed charter/time will also be charged.

- f. Additional charges will apply if Charter Bus is left in excess of not being clean. \$50.00 per hour for excess cleaning, actual costs for any materials, professional cleaning, or services. If the Charter Bus Vehicle is not able to make it to its next schedule charter, all costs associated with that missed charter/time will also be charged.
- g. There are no prices based on a "Per Person" basis. All prices are based on a "Total Vehicle" hourly rate price. Any toll charges, parking or other trip fees and/or park entrance fees are the responsibility of the customer or client.
- h. As previously stated, the following price table represents all the rates for any and all Charter and/or On-Call Service and/or Walk-On Rates.

- j. Per Diem of \$500 plus \$35 per hour waiting time will be charged in lieu of driver lodging and meal expenses for trips lasting 10 hours or more. Driver gratuities are not included. Any toll, parking or other trip fees, park entrance fees are responsibilities of the customer.
- k. Carrier may pay a commission or referral fee to agent, broker, travel agent or tour operator who arranges for the provision of transportation by the carrier to a third party so long as they commission fee does not exceed 10% of the applicable rate or charges specified in this here tariff.
- l. Rates and charges named in this tariff are applicable to waiting time, live service and deadhead time (i.e., time required from the point in time the assignment is dispatched to the point in time the vehicle returns to where it was dispatched from).

FUEL SURCHARGE TABLE AND RULES

The following Gasoline Fuel-Related Cost Price Adjustment (Surcharge) will apply on Charter Bus Service Charges, as described below.

- a. The price of regular and diesel fuel is an amount equal to the retail price per gallon of regular and diesel fuel effective on the 25th calendar day of the immediate preceding month, determined according to the United States Department of Energy, (DOE). Energy Information Administration's (EIA) survey on Weekly Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices, (PADD 5). The prices may be obtained by calling the DOE, EIA at (202)586-8800 or via the DOE, EIA website at www.eig.doe.gov via the "Petroleum" Link.
- b. If the 25th day of the calendar month is a Federal holiday, the fuel price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
- c. The DOE fuel price obtain will then be indexed based on the price matrix set forth below to determine the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharge will apply for all Bus transportation beginning on the 1st day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
- d. The fuel surcharge will be added on hourly basis utilizing the matrix set forth below. The resulting charge is in addition to all other applicable transportation charges.

Note 2: The fuel cost adjustment will be shown separately from the charter revenue on carrier transportation documents for the purpose of identifying the amount as special fuel-related revenue.

CLARIFICATIONS TO TARIFFS AND FEES:

1. Charges outlined do not include gratuity, admission fees, meals, shows, hotel accommodations or any other like charges that will be considered extras. At the request of the chartering party, these extras can be contracted and coordinated and the charge will be assessed on the charter bill.
2. Extra Charges:
 - 2.1 All costs incurred by the carrier at the request of the chartering party, or by necessity based on the itinerary or conditions, for entrance fees, parking fees or other similar incidental fees will be collected from the chartering party.
 - 2.2 Any additional mileage operated or time incurred by the carrier occasioned by an Act of God, bad conditions for the roads, the group's delay or any other circumstances beyond its control, will be charged at the hourly rate and the chartering party will be responsible for such charges.
 - 2.3 Actual Costs incurred for additional driver (s) required by reasons of the use of the charter equipment in such a manner that the original driver must be taken out of service to comply with federal or state regulations of On Duty Service regulations, will be added to all other charges.

CLARIFICATIONS TO TARIFFS AND FEES:

- 3. **Minimum Charges:** The minimum charges for charter services will be one hour. A 5% surcharge will be incurred if paying with a debit card, credit card, and a 10% surcharge if paying with multiple cards.
- 4. **Commissions:** The carrier may give a commission to an agent that has arranged the charter for the carrier with a client. Such commission shall not exceed 10% of the total charter rate.
- 5. **Damages to or in Charter Vehicle:** Any damages caused by any individual on the chartered vehicle, will be charged to the person reserving the charter service. This could include but, is not limited to: Anything broken, stolen or missing, being left in a dirty state of condition, or any bodily fluids or solids.
- 6. **Animals:** Dogs, cats, or other live animals will not be carried unless properly confined in an approved carrier. **EXCEPTION:** seeing-eye dogs in the performance of their duty guiding blind persons.

3% TAX Pursuant to SECTION 51 of AB175

The following rules apply to carriers who provide passenger transportation, excluding airport transport service:

Pursuant to Nevada Legislative Senate Bill No. 376

Sec. 36. Section 51 of Assembly Bill No. 175 of this session is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a common motor carrier of a passenger to a person or operator willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of a credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department of Taxation shall charge and collect from each common motor carrier of passengers the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to airport transfer service.

3. (Intentionally omitted)

4. As used in this section, "airport transfer service" means the transportation of passengers and their baggage in the same vehicle, except by taxicab, for a per capita charge between airports or between an airport and points and places in this State. The term does not include charter services by bus, charter services by limousine, scenic tours or special services.

Note 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

Note 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.
