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RULES AND REGULATIONS

5 APPLICATION OF TARIFF

Operate a transportation service on-call, over irregular routes and transport passengers via limousines. The Carrier is limited to no more than (5) traditional and livery limousines.

10 COMPUTATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

(a) Rates and charges named in this tariff are applicable to waiting time, deadhead and live service, and apply from the time the limousine is dispatched until its return to point of dispatch, except there will be no charge for deadhead time for transportation provided entirely within the areas of Las Vegas Valley bounded by Hwy 515/95 to the North and North East, Desert Inn/Pecos Rd. to the East, Windmill Parkway and Blue Diamond Road to the South and Rainbow Blvd. to the West.

(b) Commission of Referral Fee: The Carrier at its sole option may pay a commission or referral fee to a travel agent, tour broker, tour operator or hotel casino and any agent who arranges for the provision of transportation by the Carrier to a third party, so long as the commission or referral fee does not exceed 10% of the applicable rate or charge specified in this tariff for the transportation provided.

15 BAGGAGE

- a) Hand baggage shall not exceed forty (40) pounds per each bag per adult passenger;
- b) Articles with sharp edges will not be carried unless securely and safely packaged;
- c) Explosives, inflammables, or harmful liquids will not be transported.

25 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

Carrier reserves the right to refuse transportation to any person under the influence of intoxicants or drugs, or incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or whose conduct is likely to be objectionable to other passengers.

Exception: Incapacitated or ill persons accompanied by a nurse or guardian.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

30 LIABILITY

- (a) Carrier will not be responsible or liable to passengers for personal articles lost by or stolen from passengers.
- (b) Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage, luggage or the contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of due care on the part of the carrier or its agents. Carrier's liability will be limited to the reasonable value of the lost or damaged baggage or luggage, but in no event shall exceed two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for any single piece of luggage or baggage, including the contents thereof.
- (c) Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an Act of God, public enemies, terrorism, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, and hazards or dangers incident to a state of war, accident, breakdowns, bad road conditions, storms, and other conditions beyond its control, and does not guarantee arrival or departure from any point at a specified time. Carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule in the charter order but the same is not guaranteed. If any of the above actions occur and make it, in the sole opinion of the Carrier, inadvisable to operate a vehicle rather from the place of origin or any point en route, the Carrier shall not be liable therefore, or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

CLAIMS

NAC 706.333 Claims for lost or damaged freight or baggage. (NRS 706.171).

- 1. A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for a lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered.
 - 2. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall:
 - a) Compensate the shipper or consignor; or
 - b) Deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim.
- A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Nevada Transportation Authority.

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CANCELLATION

Notice of cancellation by the passenger / party, to be without charge, must be given to the carrier not less than two (2) hours prior to the original departure time. If notice of cancellation by the passenger / party is not timely given, a charge equal to the minimum charge for the service originally will be due.

CANCELLATION CHARGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 50

- Note 1: Airport Parking / Toll Fee: A fee of \$6.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service where the carrier is required to pay an airport parking fee to the Clark County Department of Aviation.
- Note 2: Airport Assistance Fee: A fee of \$10.00 per vehicle will apply to all charter service where the driver is required to meet passengers inside the airport to assist them with their luggage and escort them to the vehicle.
- Note 3: Fuel cost price adjustment (Surcharge) will apply (See enclosed as accepted by the Nevada Transportation Authority).

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FUEL SURCHARGE TABLE AND RULES**

The following Gasoline Fuel-Related Cost Price Adjustment (Surcharge) will apply on Charter Bus Service Charges, as described below.

- a. The price of regular and diesel fuel is an amount equal to the retail price per gallon of regular and diesel fuel effective on the 25th calendar day of the immediate preceding month, determined according to the United States Department of Energy, (DOE). Energy Information Administration's (EIA) survey on Weekly Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices, (PADD 5). The prices may be obtained by calling the DOE, EIA at (202)586-8800 or via the DOE, EIA website at www.eig.doe.gov via the "Petroleum" Link.
- b. If the 25th day of the calendar month is a Federal holiday, the fuel price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
- c. The DOE fuel price obtain will then be indexed based on the price matrix set forth below to determine the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharge will apply for all Bus transportation beginning on the 1st day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
- d. The fuel surcharge will be added on hourly basis utilizing the matrix set forth below. The resulting charge is in addition to all other applicable transportation charges.

Note 1: The fuel surcharge that is applicable for a given month must be passed along to all customers.

Note 2: The fuel cost adjustment will be shown separately from the charter revenue on carrier transportation documents for the purpose of identifying the amount as special fuel-related revenue.

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3% TAX Pursuant to SECTION 51 of AB175

The following applies to carriers who provide passenger transportation by taxicab:

Pursuant to Nevada Legislative Senate Bill No. 376

Sec. 37. Section 52 of Assembly Bill No. 175 of this session is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 52. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a certificate holder of a passenger to a taxicab willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of a credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department of Taxation shall charge and collect from each certificate holder the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

Note 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

Note 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.

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
