Re: NTA License for Golf cart



Thank you so much for calling me and advising me.

What I am trying to do is perhaps get a type of waiver from the normal NTA license for operations of a golf cart (6 seats) to transport tourists in Virginia City. Many of our tourists are unable to walk to many of our local attractions due to many steep walkways and streets. The business (Golf cart transportation) would be connected in a fashion to the Virginia City Tourist Authority so they can contact me by phone or 2-way radio for pick-up of tourist to ride down to the train station , ST. Mary's church , Fourth Ward School etc. Virginia City is almost uphill in all directions. There will be no fee for rides but tips would be accepted to help maintain and operate the cart.

The operation is seasonal, approximately 6-7 months of the year. Operations would generally be on Friday, Saturday and Sunday with exception of some special events and holidays that fall on the other days of the week.

The golf cart is a six person cart. The cart will have head lights, tail and brake lights, N.D.O.T approved tires. There will be an N.D.O.T inspection that is mandatory before operations may begin.

This service will be for tourists convenience so the will be able to see all of our towns attractions and visit as many of our businesses as possible.

The insurance policy will be for a million dollars which will hold Storey County non-labile. I have contracted an insurance an insurance agent in Reno. I have already purchased a state business license but will do me no good if I am unable to get the N.T.A license or waiver.

Enclosed is a copy of Storey county requirements and a map of areas of transport for the county business license.

There will be no fees for rides. Tips would be accepted for rides if the rider feels inclined to do so. The tips will help maintain and operate the cart with possible profit in approximately 3 years of seasonal operations. This would be a privately owned operation by myself. It is a private solution for a public need.

After twenty plus years of working for the state I plan on retiring this June, I need something to retire to. This will give me an opportunity to stay busy and meet people from all over the country and the world. This will not be an occupation or business per say. The startup costs \$3000 for the golf cart \$200 state business license \$220 county business license approximately \$2000 a year for insurance, N.D.O.T inspection fee N.T.A license and maintenance. All of this is really not cost effective for something that that brings in approximately three to five thousand dollars a season, but it would be fun and possibly break even in 2 to 3 years.



Mr. Fackler:



The Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") received your letter on May 15, 2015 detailing your intended practices as it relates to transportation of passengers. For the reasons set forth herein, your letter will be construed as a Request for Exemption.

Based upon the specific description of your intended operation as set forth in your request, you are not "employed" by your passengers and you are not engaged in a gainful occupation on the highways. Accordingly, the services you intend to provide are **exempt** from the requirements of obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, pursuant to NRS 706.041 and NRS 706.151.

Please be reminded that the services you provide must be consistent with the services described in your request. Specifically, the exemption of your operation is based upon the following factors: 1) that the service is provided **at no charge**; 2) that tipping is discretionary; 3) that tip revenue is nominal and largely (if not entirely) consumed by operating expenses; 4) that the operation is neither intended nor expected to generate economic benefit—whether direct or indirect, tangible or intangible—for yourself or any other person volunteering in the enterprise; 5) that the vehicle is locally licensed for the operation and insured in compliance with local regulation; 6) that your personal and social enjoyment are the primary motivations for providing the service; and 7) all transportation will be provided only in a golf cart and not in any form of on-road passenger vehicle.

Should you decide to change your operating procedures, please contact our office for reconsideration. Any use of the vehicles outside of the description you have presented may be in conflict with Nevada State law and could subject you to citations and/or the impoundment of your vehicles.

Please place a copy of this letter in each of your vehicles. If you have any questions, please contact Liz Babcock, Applications Manager, at the above telephone number, extension 409.

Hi Jason,

As we discussed this date, the prior operator of this free shuttle was the Virginia City Convention and Tourism Authority ("VCCTA") and as such they were exempt from the NTA regulations because they qualify as a "local government" under NRS 706.354.474. That is how they were able to operate. You do not fall under the same definition. I suggest you get some help in preparing this application. As I see it you do not qualify. You may not operate for tips (as addressed on your business license).

Here is the list of items you will need to address on the application:

1. This is for the company you will operate the transportation under –
2. How will these people be your "customers?"
3. Will you be doing any advertising?
4. You do not have a business therefore how will this apply?
5. How will you comply with this?
6. Answer is OK
7. Contradicts your business license
8. OK
9. How will you be compensated for your time and expenses? Gas, insurance, etc.
10. Is the place of business your home?
11. OK
12. OK
13. What name will be on the vehicle?
14. OK
15. Business license indicates working for tips
16. Provide copy of vehicle registration

Given your plans to operate you will need to be able to explain how you will comply with the regulation. You can appear in person at our Reno office or online on the Webex meeting. It would be helpful if the VCCTA were filing for this like they did in 2010. As we discussed, you have the right to ask for anything that you want. I know you said the Sheriff was helping you and maybe he can help you with this.




