Chairman Hartung wished all those present a safe and uneventful holiday. Commissioner Gibbons mentioned the tragic event at UNLV and asked that all those involved be remembered. Commissioner Groover mentioned the changes law enforcement has made since the 1 October event and commended the Authority's Enforcement staff.

10. Briefing from the Deputy Commissioner

Deputy Commissioner Rickert extended congratulations to Hope DiBartolomeo and Desiree Main, both of whom received promotions. He briefly discussed the ongoing acquisition for new technology for the driver permitting database, that the F1 event was very successful, with respect to driver permitting and inspections. He stated the SuperBowl planning was to continue. He also stated that the policies and procedures continue to be streamlined. He echoed the comments made by the Commissioners regarding the event at UNLV and also commended Enforcement Staff on their response.

11. Report of Legal Counsel

Senior Deputy Attorney General Csoka reported the courts found favorably for the Authority in the Sierra West, Highroller and Marji matters, that in the WMT matter, filings were due January 16, 2024 and that the Western Trails matter was in Federal Court.
