Acting Interim Administrative Attorney Csoka read an email into the record, stating the Item should go forward on today’s Agenda. Jason Perez, General Manager, LifeTrans read a statement from his attorney, Neal Tomlinson, Esq. into the record. Brent Carson, Esq. offered the opinion that the Authority should not issue the Compliance Order with the number of outstanding citations against the Applicant. James Kent, Esq. agreed with Mr. Carson regarding the final adjudication of citations. Deputy Attorney General Kunnel suggested the Hearing Officer make a ruling on the Motion for the Continuance, Acting Interim Administrative Attorney Csoka agreed. A discussion ensued.
