NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION and NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") will hold a public hearing on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 23</u>, <u>2024</u>, <u>at 1:30 p.m.</u> The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons and for the Authority to take action regarding the adoption and amendment of regulations that pertain to NAC 706. The proposed regulations and amendments have been designated as <u>Docket 23-03034</u> by the Authority and as Nevada Legislative Counsel Bureau <u>File Nos. R040-23</u>, <u>R041-23</u>, <u>R042-23</u>, <u>R043-23</u> and <u>R044-23</u>.

Interested persons who wish to address their comments, data, views or arguments in written form may do so. Written submissions must be received by the Authority no later than 5:00 pm, July 9, 2024. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed revisions appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Authority may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

- 1. The proposed amendment of certain regulations in Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 706 are to conform with the Governor's Executive Order 2023-003 to streamline, clarify, reduce, or improve the existing regulations.
- 2. The estimated impact of the regulations:
 - a) The proposed regulations will not have a significant adverse or beneficial economic impact upon the regulated industry, either immediately or long-term.
 - b) The proposed regulations will not have a significant adverse or beneficial economic impact upon the public, either immediately or long-term.

The Authority notes that these assessments of impact are limited to the impacts of the proposed amended regulations themselves.

- 3. The Authority determined the impact on small business as required pursuant to NRS 233B.0608 by taking and analyzing verbal comments from the public and from businesses to be affected by the proposed regulations in public in a workshop held on April 21, 2023.
- 4. The Authority does not anticipate incurring additional costs for the implementation and enforcement of the proposed regulations.
- 5. The Authority is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the proposed regulations with any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies.
- 6. The proposed regulations are not required pursuant to federal law.
- 7. The proposed regulations are not more stringent than any federal regulation that regulates the same activity.
- 8. The proposed regulations do not establish a new fee or increase an existing fee. However, one of the proposed new regulations found in LCB File No. R040-23 proposes to impose an administrative fine if a fully regulated carrier fails to comply with the minimum equity capital requirement for two consecutive years.

For the remainder of the agenda, during items designated "for possible action" that are considered individually, public comment will only be heard about the specific item being considered by the Commission.

Irrelevant statements, unduly repetitious statements, and personal attacks that would objectively antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited. All comments are to be directed to the Commission as a whole. During this period of public comment, speakers may address any matter either on or off the agenda.
