NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Nevada Coaches, LLC d/b/a Showtime Tours (“Showtime”) and Omni Limousine, Inc. (“Omni ”) (jointly “Applicants”) have filed a joint application, designated as Docket 19-03033, with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) seeking approval to temporarily transfer the operating rights, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) 706.359, for services conducted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 2044, Sub 2, from Showtime to Omni for a period of two years or until the Authority’s approval of the sale and transfer, whichever comes first. This application may include tariff modifications. Additionally, the Applicants have concurrently, under Docket 19-03034, requested interim authority for the transfer and to deviate from regulations to allow Omni to utilize Omni vehicles and drivers to operate the transferred authority.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

The application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Suite 200, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before May 1, 2019.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
