NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Ephrem Beyene and Ephrem Gebremedhin have filed a joint application with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority for Ephrem Beyene to sell and transfer his 50% of the membership interest of Eagle Transportation, LLC d/b/a Eagle Transportation (“Eagle”) to Ephrem Gebremedhin. Eagle is a carrier authorized to provide charter bus service granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 2150, Sub 1. As a result of this sale and transfer Ephrem Gebremedhin will be the sole member of Eagle. Said application was designated as Docket 19-04007.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

The application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Suite 200, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before May 9, 2019.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
