NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Bell Trans, A Nevada Corporation d/b/a Bell Trans, Bell Limousine (“Bell”) and Kaptyn Nevada, LLC d/b/a Bell Trans, Bell Limousine (“Kaptyn”) filed a joint application with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority for Bell to sell and transfer and Kaptyn to purchase and acquire the authority to provide charter limousine, scenic tour, special service, airport transfer, and charter bus service authority granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 1023, Sub 2. Said application was designated as Docket 19-10011. They have requested that certain information remain confidential. This application may contain tariff modifications. Certificate language may be reworded.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
