NOTICE OF APPLICATION

("Carneys") and Phoenix Movers, LLC d/b/a Carneys Full Service Movers ("Phoenix") filed a joint application with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") for authority for Carneys to sell and transfer and Phoenix to purchase and acquire the authority to provide household goods moving service within Washoe, Storey, Carson City, Douglas, and Lyon Counties, Nevada on the one hand, and points and places within the State of Nevada on the other, granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") 3258, Sub 2. Said application was designated as Docket 19-10031. They have requested that certain information remain confidential. This application may contain tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.
