NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Brent Carson, Esq. filed an application with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority for SuperShuttle Las Vegas, LLC to sell and transfer and AWG Ambassador, LLC to purchase and acquire the authority to provide charter livery limousine service, airport transfer, and special services with a fleet of thirty nine (39) limousines within Clark County, Nevada on the one hand and the State of Nevada on the other, granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 1089, Sub 3. Said application was designated as Docket 20-03006. This application may include tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
