NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Brent Carson, Esq. filed a joint application with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for authority for AWG Ambassador, LLC to sell and transfer 50% of membership and Alan Waxler Group Charter Services, LLC to purchase and acquire same. AWG Ambassador is a carrier authorized to provide charter bus service with an unlimited fleet within the State of Nevada, and airport transfer and special services with a fleet of sixteen (16) buses within Clark County, Nevada, granted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 2030, Sub 2. Said application was designated as Docket 20-03007. This application may include tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before April 11, 2020.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
