

BEFORE THE NEVADA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY
AMENDED NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO EXISTING TARIFF

Shaul Marketing, Inc. d/b/a Triple 7 Movers ("Applicant") filed an application designated as Docket 21-06031 with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") for approval of a tariff modification for services conducted under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") 3350, Sub 3. The Applicant seeks modifications including, but not limited to: 1) modify Clark County drive times *to greater Las Vegas area or Boulder City and increase the rate*, 2) *modify Clark County drive times on the one hand to greater Las Vegas area or Boulder City on the other*, 3) *add a 50% deposit required on service over \$1,000 which is forfeit if the service is cancelled within three (3) days prior to the move date*, and 4) add a charge for an overnight stay when the crew would need to spend a night out of town.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") and Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

This application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Nevada Transportation Authority at 3300 W. Sahara Ave. Suite 200, Las Vegas, NV 89102.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority's office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority's regulations and must be filed on or before July 26, 2021.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority's offices. Protests must conform to the Authority's regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
