NOTICE OF APPLICATION

AWG Ambassador, LLC d/b/a, AWG Charter Services, AWG Ambassador (“Applicant”) filed an application, designated as Docket 21-09001 with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) seeking an expansion of authority under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) 1089, Sub 4. The Applicant seeks to expand its authority FROM livery limousine service, special services, and airport transfer services TO traditional and livery limousine service, special services, and airport transfer services. The Applicant has transferred CPCN 1089, Sub 4, to Personal Sedan Service, LLC d/b/a PSS under Docket 21-04034. The Application may contain tariff modifications.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the NRS and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

The application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Suite 200, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in the filing may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority’s office. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority’s regulations and must be filed on or before October 4, 2021.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority’s offices. Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
