NOTICE OF REQUEST TO TEMPORARILY DISCONTINUE SERVICE

Frontier Movers, LLC d/b/a Frontier Movers has filed a Request, designated as Docket 22-09019 with the Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") seeking approval to temporarily discontinue household goods moving services within Clark, Lincoln and Nye Counties, Nevada, provided under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") 3382 from August 31, 2022 through February 28, 2023.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the NRS and the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.
