NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Zala, LLC d/b/a The Rush Hour, filed an application, designated as Docket 26-08033, with the Nevada Transportation Authority (“Authority”) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to provide transportation of passengers and their luggage in charter service by limousine, on-call, over irregular routes. All transportation must originate or terminate within Clark County, Nevada with no more than four (4) vehicles.

The application was filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code. Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter. Certain information contained in the application may be treated as confidential in accordance with NRS 706.1725 and NAC 706.1325 and, as applicable, may be requested to be treated as such pursuant to NAC 706.3949. The redacted application is on file and available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Suite 200, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene and Interested persons may submit Protests at the Authority’s office. Petitions and Protests must conform to the Authority’s regulations other written comments may also be submitted for filing, and must be filed on or before October 12, 2026.
