**APPLICATION OF CARRIERS OPERATING AUTHORITY**

Fares and charges in this tariff are limited in their application to the extent of carrier's operating authority set forth in certificate, issued by the Nevada Transportation Authority, RESTRICTED to transportation in INTRASTATE Commerce only as a common carrier by motor vehicle, as follows:

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

Fares and charges named in this tariff are stated in gross (commissionable) terms; and cover only ground transportation of passengers and their baggage, as provided in Carrier's Operating Authority in transportation operations. Rates and charges provided in this tariff, for services as ordered, shall be prepaid, or paid by established accounts within 30 days of service. Charges for services in addition to the services ordered and previously prepaid shall be paid within 48 hours of presentation of invoice or transportation bill to the debtor.

**BAGGAGE**

Hand baggage, not to exceed fifty (50) pounds in weight for each fare ticket will be carried without charge. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of reasonable care on its part and then only for the maximum liability of \$250.00 for the loss of, or damage to, any single piece of baggage, including its contents.

ITEM

---

LIABILITY

The carrier will not be liable for delays 'caused by an act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, force majeure, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms and other conditions beyond its control; and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employee; and, over routes indicated, but the same is not guaranteed.

If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigations, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to the state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms, and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from the point of origin or any point en route, the carrier will not be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

---

CLAIMS

A claim by a shipper or consignor against a common or contract motor carrier for lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall: (a) Compensate the shipper or consignor; or (b) deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim.

A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the Authority.

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

The driver of the transit vehicle will have the right to refuse to carry any person or require any passenger to leave the vehicle if the person or passenger is intoxicated, unruly or who is believed to be under the influence of narcotics.

---

PASSENGER AGENT

Carrier may elect to appoint as its agent any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel, or legal gaming operation, who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or more common points for the collection of all applicable charges and remittance thereof direct to carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier. 45

Carrier may pay a commission or referral fee to a travel agent or to a broker who arranges for the provision of transportation by the carrier to a third party, so long as the commission or referral fee does not-exceed 20% of the applicable rate or charge specified in-this tariff.

---

CANCELLATION FEE AND REFUNDS

All monies are due before the execution of the transportation. Cancellations must be made a minimum of 72 hours prior to the scheduled date/time of the transportation to receive a full refund. (During Special Events this cancellation period is extended to 14 days) Cancellations made within the 72-hour window ( 14-day window for Special Events) will forfeit 50%. Same Day Cancellations and No Shows will forfeit 100%. 50

FAIR MINIMUM

A minimum of one (1) hour of fares must be paid to warrant service being offered. 60

CHARTER SERVICES RATES AND CHARGES

Rates and Charges named in this Tariff are applicable to waiting time, live service, and "dead head" time. Dead head time is when the vehicle is without passengers and applies from the time the vehicle is dispatched until its return to point of dispatch, except there will be no charge for dead head time for transportation provided entirely within the areas of Las Vegas Valley bounded by Hwy 515/95 to the North and North East, Eastern ave to the East, Decatur blvd to the west and Warm Springs Road to the South.

When Customer transportation requiring them to be dropped off and then picked up again for further service within 60 to 90 minutes of the drop time, the trip will be considered as one continuous charter and the customer will be charged for the interim waiting time.

Holiday and Special Event- Transportation provided in conjunction with any holiday or events deemed by the Las Vegas Convention Authority to have an estimated visitor count of 20,000 people or more and includes Homecomings, Proms, Nascar, Formula 1, Electric Daisy Carnival, National Finals Rodeo, Raider's home games Consumer Electronic Show, and New Year's Eve.

**CHARTER SERVICES RATES AND CHARGES**

Charges shown below will be computed on the bases of either (1) the Hourly Rate, or (2) the Minimum Charge, whichever results in the greater charge shall apply. 1/2 hour charges will only be applied AFTER the first hour AND only if the charter ends in the first thirty minutes of a subsequent hour (i.e. 61-90 minutes, 121-150 minutes), hourly charge applies in all other situations. All charges referred to service offered in vehicles having a capacity of 16 or more persons, including the driver.

- Limousine Amenities Hourly Add Ons: Following will be a cost of \$10.00 per hour. Specifically Requested Music, Lighting Show, Bluetooth Connection, Wi-Fi Connection, Audio visual Access, and Corporate Branding in vehicle.
- A \$5.00 per hour charge will apply if clients require usage of HDMI Cables, Phone Chargers, or other connection items.
- Special Events Surcharge: will be at a cost of \$25 per hour added to the associated hourly rate.
- Specially requested Amenities, including but not limited to publications, flowers, decorations, and balloons etc.,
- Travel of 20 miles or more to obtain items: \$100.00 plus actual cost of items
- Travel of 11-19 miles to obtain items: \$75.00 plus actual cost of items
- Travel of 3-10 miles to obtain items: \$50.00 per trip plus the actual cost of requested items
- Travel of up to 2 miles to obtain items: cost will be \$25 .00 per trip plus actual cost of requested items.
- Bottled Water will be provided at a cost of \$10.00 per case
- Additional Ice will be provided upon request for \$5.00 per bag
- For vehicles equipped with bathroom: Bathroom will not be accessible unless passengers agree to additional \$250.00 Fee plus \$25.00 per hour upcharge to cover necessary sanitation and cleaning required after utilization.
- An airport fee of \$15.00 will apply on all airport arrival charters (AVI fee) for vehicles with a passenger capacity of 16; \$20.00 for vehicles with a passenger capacity from 17-26; \$30.00 for vehicles with passenger capacities of 27 or more.
- Meet and greet fee of \$15.00 will be added for all airport arrivals requiring driver to meet passengers in baggage claim. An additional \$10.00 will be charged for a personalized sign.
- Rate is exclusive of rates for accompanying staff (Interpreter services, VIP Host, or Concierge Services)
- Out-of-town charters (Charters operating outside of a 50-mile radius of Harry Reid International Airport) may be subject to an additional \$30.00 per charter hour for added mileage, and maintenance expenses.
- Any toll charges, parking, park entrance fees, or other trip fees are the responsibilities of the customer.

- The maximum driving hours per day allowed by law is 12 hours. Any long-distance trip over 6 hours driving one way requires an overnight stay at turning point, making the trip two days. A per diem of \$200.00 per night will be charged in lieu of driver lodging and meal expenses.
- The discounts given will be as follows: a 5% discount will be given for all Repeat Clients - 10% discount is given when a customer reserves simultaneously two (2) separate 1-hour minimum charters for transportation. Both hours must be reserved at the original time of booking. A 10% discount will be given to Affiliates, Military, and all Essential Workers.  
Discounts can be used in conjunction for a total of 25%.
- Hourly Minimums will be required for certain Special Events- i.e., Prom/Homecoming ( 4-6) Hours, Las Vegas Motor Speedway Events (2-4) Hours, CES Convention (10-12) Hours, Sam Boyd Events {2} Hours, etc. . . .

Cigarette burns: \$600; Sickness in vehicle \$500; Broken/missing decanters: \$50; Broken/missing glasses: \$10 each; Broken sunroof clips: \$60; Broke sunroof handle: \$100; Broke sunroof: \$350; Exit alarm: \$10; Smoking fine: \$500; Ripped seating: \$500; Broken or torn headliner: \$500; Broken Window: \$1,000.

**FUEL SURCHARGE TABLE AND RULES**

The following Fuel Surcharge Rules will apply to carriers who are authorized to provide charter service by bus and who are authorized to charge and collect a fuel surcharge:

1. The price of regular and diesel fuel is an amount equal to the retail price per gallon of regular and diesel fuel effective for the 25<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the immediately preceding month determined according to the United States Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey on Weekly Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices, Regular Grade - West Coast (PADD 5) and Weekly Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices, Diesel, All Types – West Coast (PADD 5). The prices may be obtained by calling the DOE, EIA at (202) 586-8800 or via the DOE, EIA website at [www.eia.doe.gov](http://www.eia.doe.gov), via the "Petroleum" link.
2. If the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the calendar month is a Federal holiday, the fuel price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
3. The DOE fuel price obtained will then be indexed based on the matrix set forth below to determine the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharge will apply for all charter bus transportation beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
4. The fuel surcharge will be added on an hourly basis utilizing the matrix set forth below. The resulting charge is in addition to all other applicable transportation charges.

**3% TAX Pursuant to SECTION 51 of AB175**

The following rules apply to carriers who provide passenger transportation, excluding airport transport service:

**Pursuant to Nevada Legislative Senate Bill No. 376**

**Sec. 36. Section 51 of Assembly Bill No. 175** of this session is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a common motor carrier of a passenger to a person or operator willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of a credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department of Taxation shall charge and collect from each common motor carrier of passengers the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to an airport transfer service.

3. (Intentionally omitted)

4. As used in this section, "airport transfer service" means the transportation of passengers and their baggage in the same vehicle, except by taxicab, for a per capita charge between airports or between an airport and points and places in this State. The term does not include charter services by bus, charter services by limousine, scenic tours or special services.

NOTE 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.
