Scenic Tours Rates and Charges

Tour Rates:

Tour rates will be charged assuming 1-2 passengers, round trip, additional passengers will charge \$20 per person are as follows:

Route:

A. Reno Area Tour Half Day Tour: \$250

Pick up/drop off location: Determined prior to agreement - Reno hotel around agreed upon areas of Reno, including downtown Reno and/or Sparks, Wingfield Springs, Rattlesnake Mountain overlook (depending on weather).

B. Lake Tahoe Full and Half Day Tours: \$500 and \$300 respectively.

Pick up/drop off location: Determined prior to agreement – Reno hotel up to Tahoe to scenic areas such as Emerald Bay, South Tahoe, Stateline, Incline Village, and Hurricane Bay depending on time available.

C. Tour to surrounding Reno Areas Half Day Tours: \$400

Pick up/drop off location: Determined prior to agreement – Reno hotel to surrounding areas such as Virginia City, Carson City, and Truckee, allowing for expanded tour options.

D. Multiday Customized Tours - \$500 per day

Pick up in Washoe County, Drop off determined prior to departure. The tour would be fully customizable by the guest, driving through scenic areas, such as Tahoe, Topaz Lake, Mammoth, Death Valley, and Las Vegas, site seeing would depend on the number of days available. Before this tour is offered, Khalil will be licensed by US DOT.

NOTE 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.

CANCELTION CHARGES:

Customer Cancellations made less than 24 hours prior to the scheduled departure will be non-refundable. Customer Cancellations made more than 24 hours prior to the scheduled departure will be fully refundable. Minimum number of guests to perform the above round-trip tour is 1 maximum is 7.

Rules & Regulations

1. Liability: Reno Outdoors, LLC will not be liable for any personal items brought onto the vehicle. The driver will make an effort to return items; however, lost or stolen items will not be the responsibility of Reno Outdoors, LLC.
2. Smoking and Drug Policy: No smoking or drugs will be allowed on any Reno Outdoors, LLC vehicles.
3. Objectionable Person: The driver of the transit vehicle will have the right to refuse to carry any person and may require any passenger to leave the vehicle if the person or passenger is intoxicated, unruly, or who is believed to be under the influence of narcotics.
4. Animals: Animals other than "seeing eye" dogs, will not be carried. (i.e. no emotional support animals will be allowed in Reno Outdoors, LLC vehicles.)
5. Children Unaccompanied: No person under the age of 18 years of age will be permitted to take part in services unless a parent, guardian or other responsible adult accompanies the minor. An adult will be defined as the parent or guardian who is 18 years of age or older and ultimately responsible for the care and supervision of the child.
6. Non-Discrimination: Reno Outdoors, LLC will not refuse service to anyone because of race, creed, sex, religion or national origin.
7. Seat Belts: All passengers will be required to fasten the provided seat belts at anytime the vehicle is moving. Reno Outdoors, LLC reserves the right to refuse service to any person who cannot or refuses to wear a seat belt.

Application of Tariff: Reno Outdoors, LLC operates a scenic tours transportation company, over irregular routes using a company vehicle to provide intrastate and interstate passenger transportation in the form of scenic tours. All Transportation must originate **OR** terminate within Washoe County, Nevada.

- 8. Baggage: Explosives, inflammables, or harmful liquids will not be transported.
- 9. Liability: Pursuant to NAC 706.333, a claim by a shipper or consignor against a common motor carrier for a lost or damaged freight or baggage must be submitted to the carrier within seven (7) days after the loss or damage is discovered. Thereafter, within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall either (a) compensate the shipper or consignor or (b) deliver to the shipper or consignor a written denial of the claim. A denial of the claim may be appealed by the shipper or consignor to the NTA. Carrier will not be liable for the loss or damage to baggage or their contents unless such loss or damage is caused by lack of responsible care and then only for the reasonable value thereof, subject to a maximum liability of \$250 for the loss of, or damage, to any single piece of baggage, including contents.
- 10. Limit of Liability: Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an act of god, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, accidents, breakdowns, highway conditions, or any other conditions beyond its control and does not guarantee arrival or departure time from any given point at any specified time. However, the carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by the contracting party but the same is not guaranteed. If in the opinion of the carrier, an act of god, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, accidents, breakdowns, highway conditions, or any other condition beyond its control, makes it inadvisable to operate its equipment from the point of origin or any point enroute, the carrier shall not be liable therefore or be caused to be held for damages for any reasons whatsoever.

3% TAX Pursuant to NRS 372B.150

The following rules apply to carriers who provide passenger transportation, excluding airport transport service:

Pursuant to Nevada NRS 372B.150

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a common motor carrier of a passenger to a person or operator willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of a credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department shall charge and collect from each common motor carrier of passengers the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to an airport transfer service.

3. The excise tax collected by the Department pursuant to subsection 1 must be deposited with the State Treasurer in accordance with the provisions of NRS 372B.170.

4. As used in this section, "airport transfer service" means the transportation of passengers and their baggage in the same vehicle, except by taxicab, for a per capita charge between airports or between an airport and points and places in this State. The term does not include charter services by bus, charter services by limousine, scenic tours or special services.

NOTE 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.
