<p style="text-align: center;"><b>APPLICATION OF FARES</b></p> <p>Fares named in this tariff cover the transportation of passengers and their baggage between all airports located in Clark County, on the one hand and on the other, all points and places in Clark County, Nevada, where said traffic may originate or terminate.</p>	30
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>APPLICATION OF RATES AND CHARGES</b></p> <p>Rates named herein are for the transportation of passengers and their baggage buses between all airports located in Clark County, Nevada on the one hand and points and places in Clark County, Nevada on the other hand. Fares are published to apply from the point of beginning to destination.</p>	40
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>LIABILITY</b></p> <p>The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an Act of God, Public Enemies, Authority of Law, Quarantine, Riots, Strikes, Accident, Breakdowns, Bad conditions of the road, Storms, or any other condition beyond its control, and does not guarantee arrival or departure time from any given point at any specified time. However, the carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent and/or employee but the same is not guaranteed.</p> <p>If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigations, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to the state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from the point of origin or any point enroute, the carrier shall not be liable therefor, or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.</p>	50
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CLAIMS</b></p> <p>A claim for lost or damaged baggage must be submitted within 7 days after the loss or damage is discovered. Within 14 days after receipt of the claim, the carrier shall: (a) Compensate the shipper; or (b) Deliver to the shipper a written denial of the claim. A denial of a claim may be appealed by the shipper to the Nevada Transportation Authority.</p>	60
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS</b></p> <p>The driver of the vehicle shall have the right to refuse to carry any person or require any passenger to leave the vehicle if the person or the passenger is intoxicated, unruly or believed to be under the influence of narcotics.</p>	70
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ANIMALS</b></p> <p>Animals, other than "Seeing eye dogs" will not be carried.</p>	80
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PASSENGER AGENT</b></p> <p>Carrier may elect to appoint as its agent any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel or legal gaming operation who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or more common points of collection of all applicable charges and remittance thereof directly to the carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier.</p>	90

COMMISSION TO AUTHORIZED AGENTS Commissions shall be paid in accordance with NAC 706.311 Uniform rates, authorization of commission or referral fee. List of designated agents.		100
PASSENGER BEHAVIOR The carrier will refuse to carry a passenger or will remove, at any proper point enroute, any person whose physical or mental behavior, is such, as to render him incapable of caring for himself without assistance, render him objectionable to other passengers, or involve any hazard or risk to other persons or property being transported. EXCEPTION: <i>This item does not apply to persons who are ill and are accompanied by attendant or nurse.</i>		110
REARRANGE OF ROUTE Any itinerary may be altered, reversed or rearranged in sequence at the option of the carrier, provided that no points of interest are omitted; unless there is specific cause such as road hazards, etc.		120
RESERVATIONS Reservations of certain seats will not be made. The carrier reserves to itself full control as to the seating of passengers, and reserves the right to change such seating at any time during the trip; however, that seating arrangement will be made without regard to race, color, creed, sex or national origin. Carrier reserves the right to transfer passengers from one vehicle to another, at any time during the trip, whenever operating conditions require.		130
STOPOVERS There are no stopover privileges on any Airport Transfer Service performed by the carrier for its passengers, except when such stopovers are an actual part of the itinerary. Passengers will be discharged only at points authorized in carriers respective Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.		140
