Rules & Regulations

APPLICATION OF TARIFF

Fares and charges named in this tariff are stated in gross (commissionable) terms; and cover only ground transportation of passengers and their baggage, as provided in Carrier's Operation Authority in charter operations. Rates and charges provided in this tariff, for services ordered, shall be prepaid or paid by established accounts within 30 days of service. Charges for services in addition to the services ordered and previously prepaid shall be paid within 24 hours of presentation of invoice or transportation bill to debtor.

APPLICATION OF RATES AND CHARTERS

All charges herein are shown in dollars and cents and are payable in lawful United States Money

The charges published in this tariff are based upon the total number of vehicles necessary to transport the charter party plus extra accommodations. If the total number of passengers exceeds the capacity of one vehicle, the charges shown herein will be applied separately to each charter vehicle used.

Charges named herein do not include gratuities, admission fees, meals, shows, hotel accommodations or any other like charges. At the request of the charter party, carrier MAY make arrangements on the charter party's behalf for rooms, food and other activities as requested by the charter party. The cost of these arrangements will be added to all other charters.

Charges for transportation and other arrangements are due and payable as specified on each individual charter service confirmation.

Charges named herein include service of the vehicle and driver unless otherwise stated.

ANIMALS

Animals, other than "Guide Dogs" or other animals that assist a person with disabilities will not be carried without prior arrangements with the carrier and unless the animal is properly confined.

LIMIT OF BAGGAGE LIABILITY

Hand baggage, not to exceed seventy (70) pounds in weight for each fare ticket will be carried without charge. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or contents thereof unless occasioned by lack of reasonable care on its part and then only for the maximum liability of \$200.00 for the loss of, or any single piece of baggage, including its contents.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY

The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by an ACT of GOD, Public Enemies, Authority of Law, Quarantine, Riots, Strikes, Accidents, Breakdowns, Highway/Roadway Conditions, Weather, and other conditions beyond its control; and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employee; and over routes indicated but the same is not guaranteed.

If any Act of God, Public Enemy, Authority of Law, Quarantine, Riots, Strikes, the Hazards of Dangers incident to the State of War, Accidents, Breakdowns, Hazardous Road Conditions, bad conditions of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either from point of origin or any point en route, the carrier not be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

CLAIMS

- (1) A claim by a consignor against a common or contract carrier for lost or damaged baggage must be submitted to the carrier within seven (7) days after the loss or damage is discovered.
- (2) Within fourteen (14) days after the receipt of the claim, the carrier shall:
 - a. Compensate consignor
 - b. Deliver to the consignor a written denial of the claim.
- (3) A denial of a claim may be appealed by the consignor to the Authority.

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

The operator of the carrier's vehicle will have the right to refuse to carry any person or require to have any passenger leave the vehicle if the person or passenger is intoxicated, unruly, or is believed to be under the influence of narcotics.

CANCELLATIONS

Carrier reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee in the event that the request for transportation is canceled less than Twenty-Four (24) hours from the time of notification or time of requested service. This fee shall be \$250.00 unless request is canceled after the equipment has arrived at the departure destination, in which case such fee shall then be the minimum charge for the transportation service confirmed.

EQUIPMENT SUBSTITUTION

When scheduled equipment is not available or due to the total number of passengers, carrier may at their discretion, substitute equipment.

AGENT

Carrier may elect to appoint as its agent any organization, firm, corporation, motel, hotel, or legal gaming operations, who individually or collectively, desire to obtain passenger bus transportation service between one or more common points for collection of all applicable charges and remittance thereof direct to the carrier without individual passenger fare collection by the carrier.

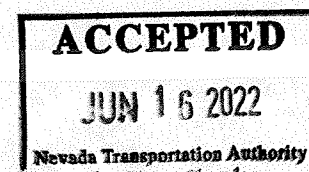

DIESEL FUEL SURCHARGE/PRICE PER GALLON

The following diesel fuel related cost price adjustment (surcharge) will be applied to all charter transportation charges as described below:

1. On the 25th day of each calendar month, the price per gallon of diesel will be determined based on the price stated by the United States Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey on "Retail On Highway Diesel Prices – West Coast Average". The prices may be obtained by calling the DOE, EIA at (202) 586-8800 or via the DOE, EIA website at www.eia.doe.gov.
2. If the 25th day of the calendar month is a Federal Holiday, the fuel price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day.
3. The DOE fuel price obtained will then be indexed based on the diesel fuel cost price adjustment factor as set forth in the fuel price matrix below to determine the fuel cost price adjustment (surcharge) that will become applicable the first day of the following month. The fuel surcharge will apply to all charter transportation reservations booked beginning on the 1st day of the following month and will remain in effect through the last day of that calendar month.
4. The fuel surcharge will be applied to all charter rates including Live Mileage or Time, whichever is greater.
5. The fuel surcharge, if applicable on any given month will be passed along to customers.
6. The fuel surcharge must be shown separately from the charter revenue on the carrier transportation documents for the purpose of identifying the amount as special fuel-related revenue.
7. The fuel surcharge will be shown separately from other rates.
8. Fuel is based on total amount of charter minus any gratuities.

3% TAX Pursuant to SECTION 51 of AB175

The following rules apply to carriers who provide passenger transportation, excluding airport transport service:

Pursuant to Nevada Legislative Senate Bill No. 376

Sec. 36. Section 51 of Assembly Bill No. 175 of this session is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and in addition to any other fee or assessment imposed pursuant to this chapter, an excise tax is hereby imposed on the connection, whether by dispatch or other means, made by a common motor carrier of a passenger to a person or operator willing to transport the passenger at the rate of 3 percent of the total fare charged for the transportation, which must include, without limitation, all fees, surcharges, technology fees, convenience charges for the use of a credit or debit card and any other amount that is part of the fare. The Department of Taxation shall charge and collect from each common motor carrier of passengers the excise tax imposed by this subsection.

2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to an airport transfer service.

3. (Intentionally omitted)

4. As used in this section, "airport transfer service" means the transportation of passengers and their baggage in the same vehicle, except by taxicab, for a per capita charge between airports or between an airport and points and places in this State. The term does not include charter services by bus, charter services by limousine, scenic tours or special services.

NOTE 1: The passenger transportation recovery charge must be passed along to all customers.

NOTE 2: The 3% passenger transportation recovery charge must be shown separately from the total fare as defined above.
