APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

Fares and charges named in this tariff are stated in gross (commissionable) terms, and cover only ground transportation of passengers and their baggage; as provided in Carrier's Operating Authority in transportation operations. Fares and charges provided in this tariff, for services as ordered, shall be prepaid or paid by established accounts within 30 days of service. Any late payments will be subject to a 10% late fee. Charges for services in addition to the services ordered and previously prepaid shall be paid within 24 hours of presentation of invoice or transportation bill to debtor.

BAGGAGE

Hand baggage, not to exceed the hundred (100) pound in weight for each fare ticket will be carried without charge. No baggage other than hand baggage will be carried on any trip. Carrier will not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or contents thereof unless, occasioned by lack of responsible care on its part and then only for the maximum liability of \$25.00 for the loss of or damage to, any single piece of Baggage, including its contents.

The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employ, and over routes submitted, but the same is not guaranteed.</p> <p>If any act of God, public enemy, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incidents to the State of War, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of road, storms, and other condition beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate its equipment either than the point of origin or any point enroute; the carrier will not be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.</p>	40

This fee shall be one hundred (\$100.00), unless request is canceled after equipment has already arrived at departure destination, in which case such fee shall be the minimum charge for the transportation services.</p>	90
