**NOTICE TO ALL CARRIERS**

---

**MODIFICATION TO EXISTING TARIFFS FOR ECONOMIC RELIEF**  
**FROM COVID-19 RELATED EXPENSES**

The Authority has opened a docket, Docket No. 20-05026, authorizing motor carriers regulated by the Authority to file tariff modifications that add fees to recover the cost of providing COVID-19 related supplies and the cost of cleaning their vehicles. This cost will reflect the carrier's expense for supplies and services pursuant to guidelines by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) implemented by the State of Nevada. No other fees or rates may be included in these tariff modifications.

The Authority will publish in newspapers notice of this tariff modification docket, with the deadline for filing any petition for leave to intervene noted. Motor carriers not in active operation may request in their tariff filing interim authority for the sole purpose of effectuating the tariff changes and not for beginning or resuming operations.

By opening this tariff modification as one consolidated docket for all carriers that file, the Authority intends to allow carriers to avoid the cost of publication of the notice. Carriers must still pay the filing fee (\$10 per modified page) and the filing fee for interim authority, if applicable (\$50).

This modification to existing tariffs allows each carrier to be covered under one notice: Docket 20-05026. NTA carriers can save between \$175.00 and \$535.00 depending on their geographical authority for the costs of publication by being covered under one Noticing.
