WAREHOUSE PERMIT ANNUAL FEE – RENEWAL

ANY CARRIER WHO HAS TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED OPERATIONS FOR ANY REASON WILL NOT BE ABLE TO COMPLETE CY2023 PERMIT RENEWALS UNTIL THEY HAVE COMPLETED REQUIREMENTS TO RESUME OPERATIONS.

All carriers certificated by the Nevada Transportation Authority (NTA) must pay an annual fee of \$50 for their warehouse permit pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 712.050.

All warehouse permit(s) for storage of household goods will expire at midnight December 31, 2023. The \$50 fee for the “2024” permit is due in either of our office locations no later than 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 2, 2024.

Summary of procedure:

- Warehouse permits are only eligible for renewal if the warehouse location has not changed from prior year. A new warehouse location will require the submittal of an application.
- Permitholders must provide written notification to the Authority regarding the discontinuance of warehouse service, if applicable.
- Failure to renew the permit in a timely manner will result in penalty fees and interest and will also result in the Nevada Transportation Authority enforcement staff taking appropriate action.

All carriers must provide a renewal request, including the payment of \$50 by mail or hand delivery to either of our address locations. Upon receipt of your payment, NTA will issue a receipt for payment and the “2024” permit.

Failure to renew the permit timely will result in penalty fees and interest and will result in the Nevada Transportation Authority enforcement staff taking appropriate action.
